money one sixth part of a handkerchief of a whitish color. - I give
& bequeath to James Johnston son to Samuel Johnston forty dollars
in money to be his & his heirs forever. Then I give & bequeath to
Sally Johnston Daughter to Samuel Johnston forty dollars in money
also my feather bed bedstead & all the furniture together with all
the remainder of my wearing apparel of every kind & dispo-
sition & my Gold ring which I give to her & her heirs forever
also my Wreath. Then I order & it is my Will that my sister
Jane Dehanty get thirty Dollars out of my Estate to be hers & her
heirs forever. Then I give & bequeath to Elizabeth Dehanty Daughter
of my sister Jane, forty Dollars to be hers & her heirs forever. Then I
Order & it is my Will that Sarah Louisa Houston Daughter of George
Houston get forty Dollars to be hers & her heirs forever. I Order & it is
my Will that my Executors see & cause that I be buried in a plain
& decent manner in a well made coffin lined with good white
Cambric & in Order that my Executors be able to pay the be-
queathments before stated & come up to the Legacies of this Will
I Order that they sell my Negro Girl Lelia with any Remainder
that may be of my property at Twelve Months Credit & if it be
so that there is a remainder of my Estate after my debts & bequeath-
ments is paid still in the hands of my Executors, I Order & it
is my Will that said remainder be equally divided between
my Three Brothers in Law Viz George Dehanty, Samuel Johnston
& George Houston - Lastly I do hereby constitute & appoint my
Trusty friends George Dehanty & Samuel Johnston my Executors to execute
the my last Will & Testament, hereby Rescinding & making void all former

Item I Order & it is my Will that my sister Jane Dehanty get thirty Dollars out of my Estate to be hers & her heirs for ever. I give & bequeath to Elizabeth Dehanty Daughter of my sister Jane forty Dollars to be hers & her heirs for ever. Item I Order & it is my Will that Sarah Louisa Houston Daughter of George Houston get forty Dollars to be hers & her heirs for ever. I Order & it is my Will that my Executors see & cause that I be buried in a plain & decent manner in a neat made Coffin lined with good white Cambric & in Order that my Executors be able to pay the bequeathments before stated & come up to the bequeathments of this Will I Order that they sell my Negro Girl Celia with any Remainder that may be of my property at Twelve months Credit & if it be so that there is a remainder of my Estate after my debts & bequeathments is paid still in the hands of my Executors, I Order & it is my Will that said remainder be equally divided between my three brothers in law viz George Dehanty, Samuel Johnston & George Houston — Lastly I do hereby constitute & appoint my Trusty friends George Dehanty & Samuel Johnston my Executors to execute this my last Will & Testament, hereby Rescinding & making void all former Wills & Testaments by me made, Ratifying this & now declare to be my last Will & Testament.
