of the County of Rockingham State of N. Carolina, by
my Sound & perfect mind & memory blessed by God, Do the
21st day of August in the year of our Lord 1819 make
& publish this my last will & Testament in manner following
that is to say Inasmuch I well & consider that a
sum convenient sum after my expenses all my just &
funeral expenses be, sumptuously paid by my executors
herein after named out of the money that may then
be in hand or the product of the labor that may be made
thereon I give & bequeath to my son James Boyce my negro
boy called Harry & a note I have on him for one hundred
dollars to gether with the full interest that may be due
thereon. Also to my son John Boyce I will bequeath my
negro man Bass. Also to my son Thomas Boyce the
bequeath my negro woman Cecilia. Also to my daughter
Elizabeth Ferguson I will & order her a likely negro woman
between the age of fifteen & twenty five to be furnished & paid
for in the manner hereafter directed. It is my express will
& desire it may be distinctly understood that the said negro
woman so purchased shall be delivered unto the hand of my
daughter Elizabeth Ferguson for her own proper & personal
use during her the said Elizabeths natural life & at her death
the said negro to descend to the Heirs of her body.
Also I will bequeath to my grand daughter Elizabeth King
during her natural life time & till she can no longer
use it her body my two negroes named Edely & Goldey.
Also I will bequeath & direct that all the remainder of my property
My body clothes excepted, be sold by my executors hereafter
named for the best price that may be had at public sale
at the same place & the proceeds thereof to be appropriated to the pur-
chase of a negro woman for the use of my daughter Elizabeth
Ferguson as stated in the clause above to my said Daughter
Also it is further my will that my executors hereafter named
purchas of as above related be soon as the price
will be seen to be well & worth the same.

Be it known or certified in the year of our Lord 1819 that
I publish this my last will & Testament in the manner follow-
ing That is to say I promise I will & order that a
sum convenient him after my death all my just de-
funeral expenses be, sumptuously paid by my executors
herein after named out of the monies that may then
be in hand or the present of the like that may be made
thereon I give & bequeath to my son James Boyd my negro
boy called Harry & a note I have on him for one hundred
dollars to gotten with the full interest that may be due
thereon - Then to my son John Boyd I will & bequeath my
negro man Bassus. Then to my son Thomas Boyd the
fourty eighth my negro woman Cecilia - Then to my daughter
Elizabeth Ferguson I will & bequeath her a widow negro woman
between the age of fifteen & twenty five to be furnished & payed
for in the manner here after directed. It is my express intent
& desire it may be distinctly understood that the said negro
woman so purchased shall be delivered unto the hand of my
daughter Elizabeth Ferguson for her own proper & personal
use during her the said Elizabeths natural life & it is further
the said negro to devide to the Heirs of her body -
I will & bequeath to my grand daughter Elizabeth Sim-
mer during her natural life sum & all the increase to the same
minus other body my two negroes named Eddie & Tom
him I will train & direct that all the remainder of my property
my body clothing excepted be sold by my executors herein after
named for the best price that may be had at publick sale
there will & the proceeds thereof to be appropriated to the pur-
chase of a negro woman for the use of my daughter Elizabeth
Ferguson as stated in the above clause to my said Daughter
And it further my will that my executors hereafter named
proceed to purchase of as above before be done as the sum
of sales can be collected not exceeding six months after the
decease money becomes due & paid the proceeds of sales
being insufficient for the payment of the said negro when dead
then I will & order that my negro child now at the breast of

Negro Woman valued by man unconnected with the parties concerned & added to the sum her Money allowing my son Thomas to receive the amount of said valuation, & keep the said child stand the account of the purchase of such Negro woman not require the aid of the price of my said Negro child as valued, then & in that case it is my will that my son Thomas Boyd pay into the hand of my son John Boyd the m^r help of the valuation of my said negro child I keep it -

I will & bequeath to my son in law Francis Simons my old negro woman called Pleasant if he thinks proper to retain her, if otherwise I charge my executors to receive her under these care observing her life time she having been a faithful Slave. — Item, I will & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Ferguson & Harry Simons my body clothing to be equally divided between them. To my son in law Robert Ferguson & Francis Simons each one Doller -

And lastly I hereby make & retain my beloved son John & Thomas Boyd Executors of this my last will & Testament, Reserving all others. The bequests hitherto of the said Elizabeth Harris have in this my last will & Testament in my hand & seal the day & year above written.

Bebecca two hundred & seventy five Dollars to be paid one year after my
death, & also will to my wife my negro woman Hannah & her two young
children.
