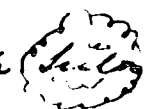


also my will & pleasure that all my body clothes together with

 property be sold & all the ready Cash now in hand
 be put to Interest & paid out by my Executors as they shall
 severally arrive to age that is the Children of Rob^t Leonard
 & of George Hutchinson each of their Children to share alike
 And lastly, I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint my
 Son & will beloved friend James Wallace to be my Executor & sole Executor
 of this my last will & Testament, and I do hereby disavow
 & disallow of all other wills, Testaments, Legacies or bequest
 made by me hereafter made or mentioned, Ratifying this to
 be my last will & Testament, In Witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 4th day of March in
 the Year of our Lord 1797-
