 to my eldest son John Penny the sum of Twenty Shillings proc.
 money of N^o Carolina. Secondly I give & bequeath to John Penny
 twenty Shillings proc. money of said province, Thirdly, I give &
 bequeath to my son William Penny a negro boy slave call. Bob
Fourthly I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary Twenty Shillings
 proc. money of said province, and Fifthly I order my negro boy
 Jacob to be sold by my Executors & the price to be divided Equa-
 lly to Rachel Penny daughter of Abraham Penny & Rachel
 Penny daughter of John Penny & Margaret Martin daugh-
 ter of Mary Martin, Sixthly I give & bequeath to Elizabeth
 & Rachel Houston daughters of Margaret Houston a negro boy
 called Lasse, Seventhly I give & bequeath to Archibald Houston
 my son in law a negro woman slave call. Fanny, for ten years
 giving four pounds per year for said Lasse every year after my
 decease & then to let her go, her if she behaves well & the sum
 arising by said Lasse to be equally divided among my Legatees
Eighthly I give & bequeath to my son William Penny my big Chest &
 big B. & a big Bible & the second volume of Marvels works to be
 delivered to William Penny & his child & his wife, who I give and
 bequeath to Rachel Penny daughter of Abraham Penny my be-
 lieved son. And I give & bequeath to Archibald Houston my
 grand son Ten pounds. - And Lastly I appoint Archibald Houston &
David Nelson to be my Executors of this my last will & Testament
 made January 5th in the year of our S^o 1775 In witness whereof I
 set my hand & seal - Signed, sealed & delivered in presence of the
