 & furniture & my Negro in my bed room including Chest
 & other things. I do hereby give to my Brother Isaac Price
 my Negro boy William & my three horses named Pearce
Henry & Griffin & I do hereby give to Isabella Campbell
 my Negro Girl Malinda. I do hereby give to Henry Cove
 my Wagon & hind gear. I do hereby give to my Mother William
Price & Isaac Price, John Henry Cove all the rest of my
 real & personal estate my just debts are paid and it
 to be equally divided between the three last mentioned.
 I do hereby give & appoint my two Brothers William Price
Isaac Price & George Henry my Executors of this my last will
 & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and seal this 30 of February in the Year of our Lord 1816

 I do hereby give to my Negro woman Mary to have the raising of
 my three Negroes to be paid to the said Mary.
