bequeath the R. Jones money & clothing before mentioned unto
my loving sister James Fort.

I do hereby will & order that the before mentioned negroes which I have
be in the care & at the disposal of John Adams untill the R. Jones
James & Nancy Adams arrive at age or marriage, together with
the increase (if any) before will'd & bequeath'd to the said James
and Thomas Adams R. Jones &c.

and lastly I do hereby nominate, constitute & appoint my true
friend & brother in law John Adams & Lewis Holloway my Executors
of this my last will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have here
unto set my hand & seal the 25th day of January A.D. 1781 -

In the name of God Amen. I Ephraim Fort of Mecklenburg County
State of N. Carolina being hereunto in body full of sound mind & memory
bless'd be God, this day the 22nd of September in the year of our Lord 1784
make & publish this my last will & Testament in manner & form
following Viz. First I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Margaret
her bed & furniture three dresses & furniture with four covers &
four Calves & a negro girl whose name is Fina the Chest & Table
& chairs & a big house & black mare & all the plantation tools
except a hoe one ad one maddock one pair of plow hors. and I
further give to her a box of bottles & seventy pounds in money
and the side of the plantation on which I now lie. which she shall
my widow & in case she should marry in consideration of the
above bequeath she shall pay unto my son David Twenty five
pounds & to my Daughter Margaret Twenty five pounds & I give
unto my son Ephraim the half of the plantation I purchased of
Masters Phifer and give unto my daughter's quality -

I give unto my son James the half of the said plantation pur-
-chased from said Phifer agreeable to quantity & quality & one ox one
Mare, one cow, one hee, one hen, Pol. & one pair of plow horses & one Bay
mare & two cows & a bed & furniture: - 4th I give & bequeath unto
my son Samuel the plantation I purchased from David Wilson &
the benefit of a piece of land adjacent obtained by a State grant
& the benefit of a warrant joining Samuel Mortons - 5th I give
& bequeath unto my son David the plantation now in on & the
remaining half of that piece of land obtained by a State grant
right as aforesaid conditioned that my said son David pay unto
my Daughter Margaret fifty pounds: - 6th I give unto my daughter
Margaret one negro girl slave named Jane: 7th I leave a negro
girl slave named Phillis one half to my Daughter Hannah
the other half to be equally divided between my sons Ephraim
James & Samuel - further I give to my son David a bay colt
that in claims: and further I give to my Daughter Hannah
the cow she purchased from me in the Spring - further I allow
my wife & children as much grain as may supply the family
to harvest ensuing - further I leave a negro man & slave named
Dick & a negro woman slave named Charlotte to my son David
& daughter Margaret to be kept on the plantation to raise
grain if they do well if not to be sold by my Executors &
the money applied to the use of my said son David & daughter
Margaret, and if neither the said David or Margaret should
die in minority the other shall have the deceaseds estate
hereby given - further I allow my wife & family as much beef
& Pork as will be sufficient for one years provision & that one
son & five herts be left on the plantation - further I give to
my Grand son Ephraim Five ten pounds, and I give & bequeath
unto my Grand son William Five ten pounds; and I give
& bequeath unto my Grand son John Five twenty pounds
and further I order what ever may remain over & above what is hereby
devised to be equally divided among my six children viz -
Hannah, Ephraim, James, Samuel, David & Margaret - further
I constitute & appoint my Executors to be L. D. Hunt and my
son in law James Wilson & David Wilson & my

my son Samuel the plantation I purchased from David Wilson &
the acreage of a piece of land adjacent obtained by a State grant
& the benefit of a warrant joining Samuel Morton - 5th I give
& bequeath unto my son David the plantation now here on & the
remaining half of that piece of land obtained by a State grant
right as aforesaid conditioned that my said son David pay unto
my Daughter Margaret fifty pounds: - 6th I give unto my daughter
Margaret one negro girl Slave named Jane: 7th I have a negro
girl Slave named Phillis one half to my Daughter Hannah
the other half to be equally divided between my sons Ephraim
James & Samuel - further I give to my son David a bay colt
that in claims: and further I give to my Daughter Hannah
the Cow she purchased from me in the Spring - further I allow
my wife & children as much grain as may supply the family
to harvest ensuing, - further I have a negro man named
Dick & a negro woman Slave named Charlotte to my son David
& daughter Margaret to be kept on the plantation to raise
grain if they do well if not to be sold by my Executors &
the money applied to the use of my said son David & daughter
Margaret, and if either the said David or Margaret should
die in minority the other shall have the demands estate
hereby given - further I allow my wife & family as much beef
& Pork as will be sufficient for one years provision & that one
cow & five hogs be left on the plantation - further I give to
my Grand son Ephraim Five ten pounds, and I give & bequeath
unto my Grand son William Five ten pounds; and I give
& bequeath unto my Grand son John Five twenty pounds
and further I order whatever may remain over & above what is hereby
directed to be equally divided among my six children viz -
Hannah, Ephraim, James, Samuel, David & Margaret - further
I constitute & appoint my Trusty friends Archibald Houston & my
son in law James Wilson Executors of this my last will & testament, having
making all other wills & Testaments by me made & by my son Sam
is to put in the behoof of which he is to have one third part
& further I order my clothes & book to be equally divided

among my sons Except my big Bible which I leave to my wife Mary
 In this life whereof I have let my hand I suffered my bed the day and
 year first above written

In the name of God Amen. I Thomas Ferguson of the State of North Carolina
 Mecklenburg County being weak in body but of perfect mind & memory
 thank'd be given unto Gods calling unto mind the mortality of my
 body I knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die
 do make & ordain this my last will & testament that is to say principally & first
 of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that
 gave it & my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent
 manner at the discretion of my Sacerdote, nothing doubting but at
 the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the Almighty
 power of God. And as touching such worldly estate where with it has
 pleas'd God to bless me with in this life, and in the first place I desire
 that all my Lawfull Debts be paid & the rest to be disposed of in the
 following manner & form. I Viz I give & bequeath unto my beloved
 Son Alexander Ferguson two young persons one Girl named Sally
 the other a boy named Jeremiah - And I also give & bequeath unto
 my Daughter Marys Ferguson three young ones Viz one boy a week named
 Saml two more boys one named Matthew & the other David - And it
 also is my will & pleasure that my Negro fellows those abide with
 my family ten years on the plantation after this decease & then
 to be valued or apprais'd & divided between my son & Daughter -
 and as to the rest of my real & personal estate with the same of the
 plantation I will & positively order that it stand as in a deed
 of Gift on record excepting one third of my real & personal estate
 with the use of the plantation to my beloved wife Matly Ferguson
 during her life to me or widowhood and no longer

And I do hereby appoint & ordain my beloved wife Matly Ferguson
 & my beloved brother James Ferguson & my trusty friend
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
