 also all my kitchen furniture & ferry boat commonly called
 a flat together with one half of my cupboard, furniture (part
 of China excepted & the cupboard) to him & to hold the same, & my
 will is that out of this property he pay all my just debts & the
 remainder if there be any that he appropriate it to his own use
 2^d. I give devise & bequeath to my son in law Henry Herr
 of the State of Virginia his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns
 my negro boy called Jackson to him & to hold the same. Provided
 nevertheless & my will is that the said Henry Herr pay into the
 hands of his daughter Esther Herr or into the hands of her legal
 representative when called upon so to do the sum of Twenty
 dollars, in full consideration of his receiving the above named
 boy. Likewise also to my beloved daughter Mary Herr wife
 of the said Henry Herr I give & bequeath the feather bed
 whereon I commonly lie to gether with the red head & all the
 furniture there to belonging - 3^d I give & bequeath to my
 beloved son William now in the State of Tennessee
 his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns my negro
 girl named Cynthia to him & to hold the same. Provided
 nevertheless & my will is that the said William pay for
 her in consideration of his receiving the above named negro girl
 the sum of Twenty dollars to the hands of my Grand daughter Esther

my negro boy called Bachus to have & to hold the same, provided
nevertheless & my will is that the said Henry Herr pay into the

representative when called upon so to do the sum of Twenty
dollars, in full consideration of his receiving the above named
boy & his. Also to my beloved daughter Mary Herr wife
of the said Henry Herr I give & bequeath the feather bed
whereon I commonly lie together with the bolster & all the
furniture there to belonging - 3^d I give & bequeath to my
beloved son W. Williams W. Williams now in the State of Tennessee
his Heirs Executors Administrators or Assigns my negro
girl named Cynthia to have & to hold the same. Provided
nevertheless & my will is that the said W. Williams W. Williams pay
in consideration of his receiving the above named negro girl
Cynthia also pay into the hands of my Grand daughter Esther Herr
or into the hands of her legal representative.

in one year after my decease or at any time thereafter when legally called upon
 so to do the sum of twenty dollars the I give devise & bequeath to my son in law
George Henry of Mecklenburg County N. Carolina my Negro woman called
Obba & the child she is now pregnant with should it be born & live, to have
 to have the same, Provided nevertheless my will is that he pay into the
 hands of Ethel Sabina Holtside Price daughter of James Price now
 of Tennessee or into the hands of her legal representative in one year
 after my decease or at any time thereafter when legally called upon
 the sum of forty dollars; and also in one year after my decease
 or at any time thereafter when called upon so to do pay into the
 hands of my Executor Isaac Price the further sum of thirty dollars
 the more fully to enable him to discharge my debts and further
 more I give devise & bequeath to my daughter Obba Henry wife of
 the said George Henry my set of clothes as it stood in my husband's
 together with one half of all the other furniture of the said husband
 5th I give devise & bequeath to my grand daughter Ethel Price daughter
 of Isaac Price one feather bed & furniture like manner I give unto
 my grand daughter Ethel Henry daughter of George Henry one feather
 bed & furniture & further I give & bequeath to Ethel Price daughter
 of Isaac Price my Chest & Table, and as touching my last living of my
 her will is that it be equally divided between my two daughters
Obba Henry & Ethel Henry, and further as to any other articles of my
 property which have not been mentioned & disposed of, my will is that
 they go into the hands of my Executor to be disposed of as he may
 think proper, as to my old Negro woman named Pott my will &
 devise is that she remain with & be taken care of by my son Isaac Price
 and I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint the above
 named Isaac Price my son to be the sole Executor of this my last will
 & Testament, hereby revoking & making void all & every other will
 & wills at any time heretofore by me made, &c. declare this to be
 my last will & Testament, In witness hereof I have hereunto set my
 hand & seal this 2nd day of May in the year of our Lord 1815.
