W In the name of God Amen. North Carolina Mecklenburg
County, I Ezechiel Johnson now being in a low condition in which
body but in sound mind & memory desiring to mind the uncertainty
of life, Do make this my last will & Testament in manner & form viz
First this my will & pleasure that all my property shall be disposed
of in the following manner. 2^d It is my will & pleasure that
all my said horses saddle & bridle & the rest of my property shall
return to my father James Johnson except what shall be here
after mentioned. I leave & bequeath to my Mother one negro
boy named Melas. Also I leave & bequeath to my brother
James Johnson my best suit of clothes, the rest of my clothes
to be disposed at my Mothers discretion following my last
letter to be my whole & sole Executrix of this my last will
& Testament, hereunto I have set my hand & seal this day
of October 1820. Signed sealed & delivered in the presence
of William Blackburn
