Swaine, Joseph Heath & Stephen McRae guardians for all my  
children and I do hereby revoke & disannul all other former  
wills, Legacies or Bequests by me before this time made, ratifying  
& confirming this one other to be my last will & Testament. In witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day and year  
first above written.
