County of Chesterbury & State of Maryland, being weak
in body yet yet in perfect mind & memory thankes be to
God for it, & therefore calling to mind the mortality of my
body. & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die
I do make & ordain this my last will & testament & first of
all I give my soul unto the hands of the Almighty God. That
give it, & my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried
in a decent manner at the discretion of my Executors, and as
touching worldly affairs wherein it hath pleased God to
bless me well in this life I give & dispose of the same in the
following maner & form as follows, first of all I desire all
my lawfull debts to be paid & it is my will & pleasure that
my loving wife Rachel shall have two thirds of the wheat land
is now growing in the Ground & the one third to my son Fred
this present year, and further it is my desire that my loving wife
may have the house & buildings her lifetime & then one third
of the land if needed her lifetime or during her widowhood
and at her death or second marriage I. issue my heirs & sons
to have all my land containing by compensation 300 ac.
Preston & Friedrich & it to be divided as follows begin
at .. Oak oak just above corner on the Nth side of the creek
goes across the plantations allowing the spring we ...
make use of to the west side & the spring of the stream
to the East side & to be equally divided 150 acre in each part
but it is my desire that Preston should have the portion
whereas the house stands Friedrich the west sister
I allow my two sons Preston & Friedrich to pay all
debts only I allow Preston to be of nearly double

shall have two Choice cows of my stock & one heavy Mare with
foal, & I allow the Calf to my daughter Dorcas & likewise two
heifer Cows & one year old Heifer & likewise her foal & in addition
& what & half of the Pots, & half of the pasture, & half of the
cattle there, & likewise five sheep known by the name of
her own, And also I allow my son Frederick to have on South
Catt a last Springs calf & one sow & Pig, & one old sow
Two Sheep & one ox; And likewise it is my will & pleasure
that my loving wife Rachel Shall have for ever all the rest
of the Beating pasture of every kind that has not been
before beggar'd away to Dorcas my daughter, & likewise
the other half of the pots & pasture & cattle there together
with one sow & pigs & three Barrows & likewise her two
& Saddle & also the three foalts of the Cows & three foalts of the
oxes, And also I will & agree with my son Reuben we
now have there Two Sheep & two pair of Chains & double
trees one Cow & one Mallet & Two Hoes & one sow & pigs; & it
is my desire that my son Frederick shall have one fourth
of the Cow & one fourth of the Calf & two hoes, & further it is
my will & pleasure that my son James & my son in law Caleb
Crawford & Phipps & Morris my son in law Jacob my
son Frederick & my son in law shall have each one of them
one dollar. Out of a note coming to me from George Durkin
& the remainder of the note it is my desire that my daughter
Dorcas shall have to purchase her a Saddle; And further
it is my desire that any remainder of debt coming to me
or the remainder of the Stock & property that has not been
before mentioned or beggar'd away I allow to my two
sons Reuben & Frederick to enable them to pay my debts the
and I do hereby constict to & appoint before Death my son
Frederick my whole sole Executrix to this my last will that
mark, this containing all bearing other former writing & Testaments
& legacies by me made will & beggar'd by me, Reifying, &
confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testament.
In witness whereof the said Frederick after he had
recited the same set his hand & sign'd this day in the 13th day of

December 1808. — Signed sealed & delivered by the said
Frederick Shaffer to be his last will & testament in
the presence of us who in the presence of each other

be by me possessed or of right to me & my belonings whether
real or personal to my body & beloved brother John Hays
Spencer to his heirs forever — I further do constitute
I appoint James Fetter, Richard Barry & John Spencer
& Garrison Attorneys at Law Executors of this my last will
& Testament, hereby abjuring & revoking all
former writing by me made, declarations & publications
to be my only last will & testament in Testimony of
what I have meant to set my hand & affix my seal to.
