& State of N. Carolina, being weak in body but of sound mind & memory
Thank be to God for, therefore calling to mind & memory the mortality
of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die
Do make & declare this my last Will & Testament that is to say
principally & first of all I give my soul into the hand of Almighty
God that gave it, and my body I recommend to the earth to be
buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my Executors
and touching such worldly Estate therewith it hath pleas-
ed God to bless me in this life. I give & dispose of the same
in the following manner & form Viz 1st I give & bequeath unto
my beloved son James G. Davis Twelve pounds & Ten Shillings when
he comes, at the age of 21 to be paid by my Executors.

2nd I give & bequeath to my beloved son Great Davis Twelve, Ten Shillings to be
paid as before mentioned. — Item 3rd I give to my beloved son Robert
Davis one French Crown at my decease. Item 4th I give to my beloved
son William Davis one French Crown at my decease.

5th I further declare that all the residue of my property therefore
not bequeathed. I give unto my beloved son John Davis my
executor & that all my lawful Debt be paid out of the same
and that the balance if any to said Executors use, And further
I do declare & appoint my beloved son John Davis to execute
this my last Will & Testament In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 19th day
of January in the year of our Lord 1807.
