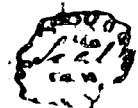


John Potts, & Margaret wife to John Patterson & Susanah wife to William

 mind I do hereby call to mind the mortality of the body & that it  
 is appointed for all men once to die, Do therefore in this my last will &  
 Testament in manner & form following Vizt I will that my just debts  
 & funeral expenses be paid & discharged as soon as convenient after my death  
 In witness whereof I give & bequeath unto my well beloved wife Bettsiah all my  
 property of whatsoever kind including my wearing apparel & household  
 my debts due to me the paying out of the same one dollar unto my  
 daughter Mary wife to Andrew Presley & that at any time when de-  
 manded after my decease. And lastly I do hereby nominate my  
 son in law Joseph M'Carroll to be the sole Executor of this my  
 last will, hereby revoking all other wills by me heretofore made  
 Ratifying & confirming this to be my last will. In WITNESSE whereof  
 I do hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 6<sup>th</sup> day of May  
 1802 Signed, Sealed, Published & pronounced  
 by the said George Hornes to be his last will in the presence  
 of us who at his request have subscribed our names
