To him his Heirs & assigns for ever - Item I give unto my beloved son Jesse Beane one still with all the implements there unto belonging to him & his Heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Sally Newbold one negro Girl named Hannah to her, her Heirs & assigns for ever. I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Sally Newbold one Shilling Sterling to her & her Heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Betty Vinson one Shilling Sterling to her & her Heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Elizabeth Baker one Shilling Sterling to her & her Heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Academy Beane a certain piece of Land or all the Land now belonging to me in Longother Neck in the County of Sussex & State of Delaware & all the property both real & personal belonging to me in that State to her & her Heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Sarah Harrington one Shilling Sterling to her & her Heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Tabitha Beane, Sarah Harrington & Sally Newbold one half of my foretotten property to be equally divided between the three to them & their Heirs, or ever. Then I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Academy Hearn a
certain piece of Land or all the lands now belonging is one in Longcher
neck in the County of Sussex & State of Delaware & all the property both
real & personal belonging to me in that State to her & her Heirs for ever.
Then I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Sarah Harrington one
Shilling Sterling to her & her Heirs for ever. Then I give & bequeath unto
my beloved Daughters Tabitha Hearn, Sarah Harrington & Sally
Newbold one half of my forgotten property to be equally divided between
the three to them & their Heirs, for ever. Then I give & bequeath unto my
beloved son Jesse Hearn whom I likewise constitute make & ordain
my only & sole executor of this my last Will & Testament all the other
half of my forgotten goods to him his Heirs & assigns for ever. And I do
hereby utterly revoke & disannul all & every other former
Testaments, Wills, Legacies & Executors by me in any wise before this

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I have written & begun to write, that I am now to be my
last will & testament, that I have written to set my hand to this
day, & give above written

Signed, sealed, published, pronounced & delivered
by the said George Heerne as his last will and
testament in presence of us

1740 I Richard Hudson of Newbury County State of N^o Carolina being
in a declining weak state of body, but of perfect mind & memory thank
be to God for his mercies & calling to mind the mortality of my body and
that it is appointed unto all men once to die, Do make & ordain
this my last will & testament, that is to say principally & first of all
I recommend my soul to Almighty God who gave it, & my body to the earth
to be buried in a decent Christian manner at the discretion of my executor
nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same
again by the mighty power of God. And as touching my worldly estate
whereunto it hath pleased God to bless me in this life, I give, devise
and dispose of in the following manner & vision, I give & give
unto my wife my well beloved wife all my Estate Real &
personal during her widowhood & if she marry again the part of estate
to be equally divided between Joseph & Richard my two youngest sons
also unto Thomas my beloved son one Dollar to my beloved son Edward
one Dollar, also to my well beloved daughter one pound & 10 shillings before
her marriage & the spinning wheel, also to Priscilla my daughter
one pound & 10 shillings, also to Elizabeth my beloved daughter one
pound & 10 shillings, also to my beloved son Joseph the plantation whereon
I now live containing two hundred acres to be by Joseph at his
mother's death or at the marriage, also to Richard my well beloved
son the plantation known by the name of Stokes containing two
hundred acres to be by him when he comes of age but in case that
one or both die before they come of age then his or her part shall be
equally divided between my four daughters Hannah & Priscilla
Elizabeth & Mary, also to my well beloved daughter one
