God. Gathering unto mind the mortality of my body & knowing
that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make & declare
this my last will & Testament, that is to say principally & first
of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of God that
you etc. And for my body I recommend it to the Earth to be buried
in a Christian like & decent manner at the discretion of my
executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection
I shall receive the same by the mighty power of God, laid as
I now stand in such mortallie estate wherewithal I placed hitherto
to help me in this life. I give, devise & dispose of the same
in the following manner & form. Hesperus is it my will
& so order that in the first place all my just debts and
funeral charges be paid & defrayed — Then I give & bequeath
to my beloved wife Margaret my black house & saddle upon
her person Davvy also one buck & jennet — These I give away
to Thomas the boy son of my saddle — As to the rest of my
estate I leave in the hands of my beloved wife Margaret Davvy

her widowhood to be improved for the use & support of herself & children to the best of her capacity in case she should die. In conditions it is my will that what may then remain of my Estate I set as well other part to be sold & equally divided amongst my children including the one that my wife is to go with the land as well as other parts of my Estate. I instruct my wife Margaret & her brother Thomas Wier who I alone constitute & declare to be my Executrix of this my last Will & Testament to sell when they see necessity for the use of family & convey a proportionable to the land when sold. I do hereby utterly disallow revoke & disannul all & every other will, instrument, Legacies & Executors by me in any wise before the time named, written & begun above, Ratifying & Confirming this & no other my last Will & Testament, in Witness whereof I have caused to set my hand & seal the day & year above written.
