wish that my wife Esther Leary shall have all my household
& kitchen furniture during her natural life or widowhood
then the same property to be equally divided between
lawful heirs, and after my just debts & funeral expen

It is my will that the balance of my property be
Equally divided between my daughter by name Esther Leary
Dorcy Leary, & Nancy Leary, & Elizabeth Leary & Emory Leary
And I hereby make & Ordain my beloved wife Esther Leary Exec^{tr}
