 & desire it may be executed by all as here. First I bequeath
 my soul to God his most glorious & merciful Father
 & through the atonement & mediation of Jesus Christ
 my Redeemer; & I give & give my body to the
 Father from whence it taken in full assurance of its Re-
 surrection at the last day. As to my worldly concerns
 my burial I desire it to be without pomp at the direction
 & discretion of my wife & children here after named —
 First I give & bequeath to my wife the house that I now
 live in, & the out buildings belonging to the premises & as
 much of the land as will support the family my wagon
 & gear, excepted, the two plows, two barrow plows, &
 two shovel plows, & harnois, also to my wife for the support
 of my family, the herd of cattle her choice of the stock
 & all my hogs & geese & Twelve head of sheep, and two
 horses Jolly & Buck, also my machine & two thirds of the
 barn hold & kitchen furniture her choice of it to the use
 of my wife during her widowhood, all the above property
 but no longer — I give & bequeath to my wife as her abso-
 lute Right for ever to dispose of as she thinks proper my
 negro Girl Shell, the Serch more full two beds & furniture
 & the clock — I also give & bequeath to my sons all the lands
 of which I am possessed to be equally divided among them
 Except the story place which I allow to be sold and a
 reasonable credit given, The division of my land will
 be made when my son Allen comes of age. — I will also
 that my negro Girl Linda be sold & my other three negroes
 be hired out to wit Rob hired for the support of the family
 Solomon & Sarah for the benefit of the School land when my
 son Allen comes of age, James & Allen shall receive their

but no longer — I give & bequeath to my wife as her abso-
=lute Right for ever to dispose of as she thinks proper my
negro Girl Abell. The said mare with two beds & furniture
& the clock — I also give & bequeath to my sons all the lands
of which I am possessed to be equally divided amongst them
Except the story place which I allow to be sold and a
reasonable profit given, The division of my land will
be made when my son Allen comes of age. — I will also
that my negro Girl Linda be sold & my other three negroes
be hired out to wit God hired for the support of the family
Edmond & Sarah for the benefit of the Estate and when my
son Allen comes of age, James & Allen shall receive their
equal share of the negroes & money that will arise, some
the sale of property & hire of negroes, and all my sons.

Each Daughter shall have equal share in the negroes & money
 when James & Ellen receive their part the remainder shall
 continue in our common stock for the benefit of my children
 who are minors & as they become of age they shall receive each
 one their part - I will also ~~bequeath~~ pay out of my estate
 my brothers & sisters to each of them the sum of money
 willed them by my father, & also that my Executors at
 the division of the land ~~shall~~ ^{shall} a portion of the land
 as they may deem necessary for the support of my wife
 during her life if she remains a widow. Also I constitute
 and appoint John Weeks & Samuel Williamson my Executors
 of this my last will & Testament - Signed & sealed with my
 hand this 30th day of December Anno Domini 1826.
