

In the Name of God Amen. I George Ross being verak on body
out of perfect mind & memory thanks be to god, therof...
aking in mind the mortalitie of my body & knowing that
it is appointed for all men to die, do make & ordain this
my last will & testamēt, That is to say principally & first
of all I give & bequeath my soul unto the hand of Almighty
god that gave it to be disposed of at his pleasure & my body
I command to be buried in the Earth in a decent manner
at the discretion of my Executors, and as touching such
worldly estate wherewith it pleased God to bless me in
this life, I give & bequeath & dispose of the same in the following
manner & form viz. I give & bequeath to Margret Ross
my dearely beloved wife the one half of all that meauege
or tract of Land on which I now dwelle including the
Buildings thereon for & cheiring her natural life, also I
give unto my said wife the best bed & furniture one black
man called Fred, one saddle & bridle, fair head boar &
half of the plantation tools for her husband to be continued
in the plantation, for the use theropf, I further give &
bequeath unto my wife all the sheep except two ewes
& the one half of the hogs. Item I give & bequeath unto Robert
Ross my beloved son twelve pound seven shillings paid for him
in the way of Debt. Item I give & bequeath to Catherina Ross
my dearely beloved daughter one horse named Yerling one
black & saddle, likewise one bed & furniture & one fine
ewe which is white, one Cow called Daisy & a two year old
Moorley heifer three hours & a breeding sow, Item I give to
bequeath unto my beloved son George Ross the remain-
ing half of the plantation & tools for her husband while
she yet Ross his mother liveth & after her death it is
my will & pleasure that him his Heirs or Offspring get all
in said tract of Land improvements & tools for Husbandry
but in case George Ross my son dies not having lawfull
Heirs then my will & pleasure is that the two thirds of said
land must be given & equally divided between my daughter
Catherina Ross my sons Robert Ross & John Ross, but
that the two remaining third part of the land be equally

Divided between my daughters Catherine Doff & Margaret Hunter, I further give & bequeath unto my son George one horse & saddle, bridle, bits & spurs, iron & one cow called White face. I her Heifer & her ~~remaining~~ half of the pigs, I likewise give & bequeath unto my son John Robert & son George out of my wife Margaret Doff's Money & treasure leave the sum of £100.00. being for the benefit of the Society & at the death of my wife I allow her to dispose of said money & Treasures at her pleasure, I further give & bequeath unto my daughter Margaret Hunter one new rifle & two I already constituted & appointed Margaret Doff my beloved wife & George Doff my beloved son to be my sole executors of this my last will & Testament; & do hereby disallow, Revoke & disannul all & every other & former wills, Testaments, Legacies & Executors by me in every wise or manner before or before attested in form, hereby Ratifying this & no other, to be my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I have affixed my seal this 13th day of Augt 1798
Signed, Sealed, Published & Delivered by the said George Doff as his last will & Testament in the presence of us, who in his presence, & in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our hands.
