body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once
to die, do make & ordain this my last will & testament
that is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend
my soul into the hand of the Almighty God that gave it
me, & my body I recommend to the earth to be buried
in decent Christian burial or else at the discretion
of my executors nothing doubting but at the general
resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
power of the Almighty God, such as Touching worldly
estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in
this life I give Dominion & despise of the same in follow-
ing manner & form; First I give & bequeath to Roddy my
dearly beloved wife wholly all my moveable estate which
she lives & after her decease what is left to be equally
divided among the children; Also I to my Eldst son
I do give & bequeath & will all my land, only he
shall by give & devise unto the rest of my children
The first sum of Ten pounds to each without fail more
or less than money had I do hereby utterly disallow
any other devise all & every other former wills, be
givings, bequests & placations by me in any wise before
named, willed & generated, Ratifying & confirming this to
be other to be my last will & testament in writing
I set my hand & seal this 16th day of August 1762.
