 3<sup>o</sup> I will that all my other property be put under the care  
 & to the use & benefit of my daughter Sally Sterling &  
 what remains of said property after her death to go to her  
 two children Robert & Amy Sterling equal divides  
 4<sup>o</sup> I ordain & appoint my Grandson Robert Sterling and  
 the knowledge of taking in with himself any other dis-  
 creet person he may choose to be & witness of this my  
 last will & testament which I desire be such as  
 I hereby revoke & disannul all former wills by me here-  
 tofore made, & publish & declare this the 20<sup>th</sup> day to be my  
 last will & testament in presence of them subscribing  
 witnesses I have hereunto set my hand &
