share of the moveable property & the hire of his Slave Bob will suffice
I desire to wish them all to live together as long as possible & if any should
break off what property they get to be deducted out of their share of the
Estate I also appoint & ordain for my daughters my daughters Mary
& James Hacy those I ordain & those I appoint to be in full possession
I give as in due as myself signed & sealed proclamation and
Subscribed 16th of March 1803

Anthony to be sold & the money arising from the sale to be
divided between them three & their alimony Item To
Grand Daughter Cecilia Harris if she should live to be 21
years of age I will one Negro girl named Sissie in case she
should not then I allow said negro girl to go to the care of

my Grand Daughter Eliza who is worth Mary Alexander share and
 have alike. Item to my Grandson James W. ~~Weller~~ & wife
 one hundred & fifty dollars. Item. to my Grand daughter Mary
 Alexander I will Twenty Dollars. Item. To my son Jonathan Harris
 I will & bequeath the whole of the remainder of my Estate as follows
 bequeath Sophia, & decide on what kind of property there may be
 left. I hereby make & declare Jonathan Harris to executer of this my
 last Will & Testament. In witness whereof I the said Grandmother
 have to this my last Will & Testament set my hand & seal the day
 11, in the year written in the presence of us.

 Mortality of Man & knowing that it is appointed for all mankind
 once to die & find myself in a low state of health through a perfect
 mind & memory & to leave it with pleasure go to His infinite love
 some of the good things of this life. It is my Will & desire to dispose
 of them in the following manner & as add. to this my last Will &
 Testament. Impriously I bequeath my soul to God who gave it
 & my body to the Earth from whence it came to be decently buried
 at the discretion of my executors which expenses to be paid out
 of the whole of my Estate. It is my Will & desire that all
 my just debts should be paid out of my Estate as soon as my Estate
 can be settled. It is my Will & desire that all my lands lying
 on the South borders of Debatory Creek, fairfield district, said
 Carolina, near to Harkley Mount, one tract containing five
 hundred acres lying on the land of Richard Gater & Mr. Poll
 carpenter brother. A tract containing one hundred & fifty acres
 adjoining Mr. Poll on the other side. Opposite the other tract
 also one small tract of fifty acres lying long side the second
 tract shall be sold & out of the net monies arising therefrom
 my just debts be all paid also five hundred sterling pounds be
 left to my son Jonathan Harris
