same & calves in preference as they are herein named that is the first born
first choice, I likewise leave unto my daughter Agnes Potts son
& to my sister in law the child of James Potts son to be paid by my
as soon as convenient after my decease, I likewise leave unto my
daughter Margaret Patterson my negroes. All my black Potters
& the rest of my wearing apparel to be equally divided between my daughter
Agnes Potts & Susan Harrison there & there alike. The rest of my property
my negroes & what else is not before herein mentioned I leave unto my
only son James & Houston, to have of & hereby nominating & appointing to be
the sole executor of this my last will, hereby revoking all other wills
heretofore made, Ratifying & confirming this to be my last will, I am
witness of & have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 29th day
of the year of our Lord 1802 - Signed sealed & acknowledged in
