money put to Interest for the use of Pamela Starn
to buy her a mare saddle & bridle when she needs the

bed & furniture, a black cow, six silver spoons &
my Stone ring—I desire that all my wearing
apparel & all my Yarn be equally divided among
my three Sisters my Mother & Senannah Morrison.
All my other effects I allow to be sold & the money

Brothers. I do constitute my beloved Brother William
Morrison & Alexander Morrison Executors of this my
