my chestnut drawers & cloth cloak to be kept my
Mother in Trust for her until she is of age. I
allow my mare saddle & bridle to sold and the
money put to interest for the use of Pamela Starr
to buy her a mare saddle & bridle when she needs them.
I bequeath to my niece Hannah Morrison my other
bed & furniture, a streak cow, six silver spoons &
my Stone ring — I desire that all my wearing
apparel & all my gear be equally divided among
my three sisters my mother & five aunts Morrison.
All my other effects I allow to be sold & the money
there arising to be equally divided among my three
brothers, I do constitute my beloved Bro. Alexander
Morrison & Alexander Morrison executors of this my
last will & Testament. In witness whereof I have
