In the name of God amen. The 22nd day of September 1769. I
Henry Farmer of the County of Rockingham Province of North
Carolina living with & near in body but of perfect mind & memory
thankes be given unto God. therefore calling to mind the mortality of
my body & knowing that it is appointed for all people on earth
to die & ordain this my last Will & Testament, that is to say
humbly & first of all I give & command my soul into the
hands of Almighty God that gave it. And my body I command
to the Earth to be Buried in a decent Christian Burial at the
discretion of my executors nothing doubting but at the ge-
neral resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
mighty power of God. And as touching such worldly estate
wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life. I give
& dispose of the same in the following manner & form —
first of all my Debts to be paid — Item I give & command
unto my Eldest & Younger son John Farmer the Land together with
the improvements wherein I now live, only that I first order the
plantation to be valued by three persons & the valuation
to be divided among each & every of my Children & after the
said John Farmer having his share of the valuation allowed to

him... is to pay the rest of my Children their share of the valuation
as they come of age — Item. I give Doctor & his wife unto my
second living Son Paul Farrow the tract of land lying the
between his own land & Paul's Barringer's land, only that of first
order that the said land to be divided by three just odds $\frac{1}{3}$ the
valuation to be divided equally among each & every of my
daughters after the said Paul Farrow having his share of the Valua-
tion & allowed to him he is to pay the rest of my Children
their shares of the valuation as they come of age —

Item. give & bequeath unto my living wife the third part of my
personal estate, only that I order that all my goods & chattels
be sold at publick auction & equally divided amongst each &
every of my Children after my wife has her third.

In Testimony whereof I the Testator Henry Farrow have here
unto set my hand & seal as of my last will & Testament &
I do hereby nominate & appoint my living wife Rosanna Farrow
& my Trusty friend Valentine Weaver the sole Executrix of this
my last will & Testament the day fifteen June written
Signed sealed & published by the testator,

County being weak of body but of sound mind & judgment, do make
this my last will & Testament & by these presents do revoke all wills
hereafter by me made either by word or writing —

I am my will to desire that my wife & children, her altogether
that I have by my wife Jane, I desire that all my estate Real
& personal be Praised & one third part of it be given my wife
Jane & the other two parts to be equally divided among my children
except my daughter Mary Franklin to whom I give one English
Sheiling I desire the Negroes to be hired out for the use of my children
till they are of age to take care of themselves. I also desire that
