her one Dollar — Lastly I make & appoint my son John Emerson

In the name of God Amen. The 22^d day of September 1869 I
Henry Furrow of the County of Richland & Province of North
Carolina being sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory
thanks be given unto God, therefore calling to mind the mortality of
my body & knowing that it is appointed for all people once to die
do make & declare this my last will & Testament, that is to say
pumpfully & of all I give & recommend my soul into the
hands of Almighty God that gave it, and my body I recommend
to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian Burial at the
discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the ge-
neral resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
mighty power of God. And as touching such worldly estate
wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I give
& dispose of the same in the following manner & form —
First of all my Debts to be paid — Item, I in devise & bequeath
unto my Eldest & Youngest son John Furrow the Land together with
the improvements wherewith I now live, only that I first order the
plantation to be valued by three freeholders & the valuation
to be divided among each & every of my Children & after the
said John Furrow having his share of the valuation allowed to

himself is to pay the rest of my Children their share of the Valuation
as they come of age - Item. I give Devise & bequeath unto my
second loving son Paul Furrer the Part of Land Lying &
between my own land & Paul Barringer's land, only that I first
order that the said Land to be Valued by three just & true & the
Valuation to be divided equally among each & every of my
& after the said Paul Furrer having his share of the Val-
uation allowed to him he is to pay the rest of my Children
their shares of the Valuation as they come of age -

Item. I give & bequeath unto my loving wife the third part of my
personal Estate, only that I order that all my goods & Chattels
be sold at public Auction & equally divided amongst each &
every of my Children after my wife has her third.

In Testimony whereof I the Testator Henry Furrer have here-
unto set my hand & seal as & for my last will & Testament &
I do hereby nominate & appoint my loving wife Rosana Furrer
& my Trusty friend Valentine Weaver the sole Executors of this
my last will & Testament the day & year above written
Signed sealed & published by the Testator
as & for his last will & Testament in the presence

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In the name of God Amen. I James Franklin of Mecklenburg
County being weak of body but of sound mind & Judgment, Do make
this my last will & Testament & by these presents do revoke all Wills
heretofore by me made either by word or Writing -
In primer. It is my will & desire that my wife & Children live all together
that I have by my wife Jane, I desire that all my estate Real
& Personal be Divided & one third part of it be given my wife
Jane & the other two parts to be equally divided among my Children
Except my Daughter Mary Franklin to whom I have an English
Shedding I desire the Negroes to be hired out for the use of my Children
till the time that they shall be able to take care of themselves & I desire that
