 merchantable wheat & ditto of the same quality twelve bushels
 of corn yearly every year to be delivered to her my said wife
 during her Natural life and also the said wheat & corn to be
 brought to the mill & the meal home again according to her
 order & direction, further I give & bequeath to her my said wife
 two Cows & two Calves, Pastorage in the Summer & fodder & good
 Stable in the winter also I give & bequeath to her my said wife my
 present bay mare & also foal & colt in winter & pasture in
 summer also I give & bequeath to her my said wife my whole stock
 of hogs, further I give & bequeath to her my said wife one hundred
 weight of Good fat pork & fifty weight of ditto Beef to be delivered

two Cows & two Calves, Pastorage in the summer & fodder & good

summer. also I give & bequeath to her my said wife my whole stock
of hogs, further I give & bequeath to her my said wife one hundred
weight of Good fat pork & fifty weight of ditto Beef to be delivered

term & condition following. I give deliver & completely fulfill all
such articles & legacies here above before mentioned specified &
enumerated of Michael Comble to me & to my wife Christiane with
out any Alteration Discrepancy or hindrance & to have &
help the Buildings, Improvements bequeathed to my wife in the
constant & best repair & neither he my said son John —
Ruperman nor his Heirs Executors, Administrators or any
agent or Creditor not to be intitled to sell the said land nor
any part of it during my said wife's natural life times
without her my said wife and my heirs to receive Exec^t
consent and also to pay forty pounds lawful money of
North Carolina into the hands of my said executors before
equalitatis & payments the first payment to be payable
twelve months after my decease & twelve months after
