mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men
once to die, I do make & declare this my last will & Testament:
That is to say principally & first of all I give my soul to God that
gave it, & my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a
decent Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors
Nothing but the great resurrection I shall receive it by the
mighty power of God. And as touching such worldly estate as
it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life, I give & dispose
of the same in the following manner & form: It is my will &
desire that all my just debts should be paid out of my estate
I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Anna Hargitt all my
household furniture & stock of all kinds & tools of agriculture
enduring of her life or her widowhood - Furthermore it is my
will & desire that my son Daniel Hargitt should have the
plantation whereon I now live with his mother's clothes and
furthermore it is my will & desire that my wife decide that all
my property that is left should be sold & equally divided
amongst all my children namely James Hargitt, Nelly
Mathews, John Hargitt, Henry Hargitt, Casper Hargitt, Wm
Hargitt, Isaac Helms, Ann Prasley, Charity Hargitt, Daniel
Hargitt, Phely Helms. - I do execute & perform all in
this, in the contents of this my last will & Testament I
constitute make & declare my Executors my beloved son
Isaac Helms & Casper Hargitt to whom in particular I
have the fullest confidence to transact the business of this
my last will & Testament and I do disallow & disannul
all & every other former Testament or will made by me
in any wise before named. And I do confirm this to be my
last will & Testament. In witness whereof I have set my
