shillings, to my son Richard £10 Sterling five shillings, to my son
Robert £10 Sterling five shillings, to my son
William £10 Sterling five shillings, likewise I leave to my son
of my plantation at my wife's death or marriage, to my son
his mare & saddle & two young ⁹ cows if he stays on the plantation
I leave my son William to take care that my son James does not
sell or lease the plantation away after his mother's death &
if the said James & William die without issue the land to be divided
equally between my three sons Robert & William & John

of the County of Northampton & State of Carolina planter, being
in a sick & weak condition but in sound mind & knowing thanks be
to God for it; therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my body &
knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, Do make &
renew this my last will & testament, making void all others
and first of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty
God that gave it, & my body I recommend to the earth to be buried
in a decent & Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors
and as touching such worldly estate to be left to it be the pleasure

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Gods to bless me in this life, I give & dispose of the same in the following
manner I give & bequeath unto James Mitchell my beloved
wife the mansion house, barn & out houses & one half of the plantation
on which I now dwell to wit all that part lying north of the same as
it now stands, the one half of the meadow & one house called the little
gray & one mare called Musell together with the one half of the plants
- Tree for Husbandry & one negro woman named Tilla & a horse
cow, six Hogs & four sheep all which shall be at her command for &
during her widowhood for the use of herself & that part of my family
which may remain with her, all which must be returned to my son
Robert as his property at her marriage or death, also I give unto her
during her natural life & to be at her disposal at death the follow-
ing Articles to wit one bed & bedding her chair one bay Horse call-
ed Saddles & Briddle, two cows, four sheep & four hogs, the one half
of the dresser furniture to be valued by two indifferent persons
Also I give & bequeath unto John Mitchell my beloved son the sum
of twenty shillings cash Also I give & bequeath unto William
Mitchell my beloved son one certain tract or parcel of land lying
southeast of the plantation on which I now live & joining the same
& being more or less adjoining to be taken from the plantation
on which I now dwell & also twenty acres lying on the corner end
of this plantation in the mouth of people run to him his heirs
& assigns forever & also one negro man named Willie Also I give &
bequeath to Robert Mitchell my beloved son all the remainder of the
plantation on which I now live to him his heirs & assigns forever, one house
named Arch & one saddle & bridle & the other half of the plantation
to be for husbandry & one new wagon covered with my old skins.
Also I further give & bequeath unto James Mitchell my beloved wife
all that tract or parcel of land lying south & joining Eliza & under
land to her, her heirs & assigns forever, & her spinning wheel. Also I
give & bequeath unto Catherine Mitchell my beloved daughter
one young mare called prince, saddle & bridle, one bed & furniture for
head of cattle cows & calves, three head of sheep & one fourth part of the dresser
furniture & her spinning wheel & one chest. Also I give & bequeath unto
James Mitchell my beloved daughter one young Gray mare saddle and
bridle one bed & bedding, six head of cattle, & three head of sheep & the other

South-east of the plantation on which I now live & joining the same
& thirty acres of Land adjoining to be taken from the plantation
on which I now dwell & also twenty acres lying on the lower end
of this plantation in the mouth of poplar run to him his Heirs
& assigns forever & also one negro man named Tilla. Then I give &
bequeath to Robert Mitchell my beloved son all the remainder of the
plantation on which I now live to him his Heirs & assigns forever, one horse
named Dick & one saddle & Griddle & the other half of the plantation
to be for Husbandry & one new Wagon covered with my old skins.
Then I further give & bequeath unto Jane Mitchell my beloved wife
all that tract or parcel of Land lying South & joining Eliza & Abraham
land to her, her Heirs & assigns forever, & her spinning wheel. Then I
give & bequeath unto Catherine Mitchell my beloved daughter
one young horse called prince, saddle & Griddle, one bed & furniture six
head of Cattle, three Swine, three head of Sheep & a fourth part of the dresser
furniture & her spinning wheel & one chest. Then I give & bequeath unto
Jane Mitchell my beloved daughter one young Gray mare saddle and
Griddle one bed & bedding, six head of Cattle, & three head of Sheep & the other
fourth part of the dresser furniture & one spinning wheel & one chest equal
to one like Catherine's one chest. It is further my will & pleasure that
all the remainder of my estate be equally divided between my wife
son Abraham, Robert & my two daughters Catherine & Jane

13/ I do hereby appoint & constitute James Mitchell my trustee and
he, he & Mitchell, my son & William W. to be my sole Executors of this
my last will & Testament, and do hereby utterly revoke & disannul
all & every other former Testament, Will, Legacies & Bequests by me
before now made, written or by word of mouth, No signing & confirming this
I do take to be my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I the
said Henry Mitchell have hereunto set my hand & seal this 3^d
day of January 1782. Signed, Sealed, pronounced & declared
by the said Henry Mitchell as his last will & Testament in the
presence of us, later in his presence & in the presence of each other
have hereunto subscribed our names

In the name of God Amen. I Hugh McQueen of the County
County of State of Virginia, being to mind the mortality of my
body & that it is appointed for all men once to die and being in perfect
mind & memory do constitute & make this my last will and
Testament. And first of all I do positively bequeath & order all my
just due to be paid out of my personal estate by my executors
hereafter named. Then I do will all the land that I am now pos-
sessor of to my son Samuel. Then I do will the negro boy named
Dick to my son Samuel, but I do allow him for his pay to
each year for the my Grand daughter Elizabeth the sum of five pounds
to be paid by him to each of them at the time that I may be thought
most convenient for him by my Executors & Guardians hereafter
named. Then I do will the one half of my land to my daughter
Mary. Then I do allow my son Samuel & my three daughters Mary
Elizabeth & Sarah each of them to be ~~be~~ portioned at the discretion of
my Executors & Guardians as near equal to my love Elizabeth &
Abigail that are provided for by the estate will allow of them dollars
or pounds to my Grand daughter Elizabeth £ 20. I do allow the
negro boy Lilla he comes of age to my son Samuel. Then I do disallow
I forbid my Lilla to be sent to sea except such things as are determinate
to be sent to sea for his use.
