ing that it is appointed for all men once to die, Do make
& declare this my last will & Testament, that is to say,
Principally & first of all, I give & recommend my soul into
the hand of the Almighty God that gave it & my body I
recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian
burial at the direction of my Executors nothing doubt-
ing but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the
same again by the mighty power of God, & as touching
such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to
bless me in this life, I give Devise & dispose of the same
in the following manner & form - First I give & bequeath
to the poor & needy, Millings & such to be raised & sold out of
my Estate. Also I give to my well beloved brother Samuel
Lewis & David Whim I likewise constitute make &
declare the sole Executors of this my last will and
Testament. All and singular my land containing
six hundred forty acres, lying on the South side.
