my Estate. Also I give to my well beloved brother Jacob
Lancaster & David whom I like wise consider much &
believe the sole Executrix of this my last will and
Testament. all and singular my land containing
six hundred forty acres, lying on the South side.

to herself. Also I give to my deare brother Michael
Readasall all my brewing blther; also I give to my
dear beloved Daughter Elizabeth Readasall the half
of all my Estate, and likewise a considerable Moneys.
