Side beneath the 10three end of the Survey to my beloved
son James Stewart his Heirs & assigns forever & the remain-
der of said tract to be sold & the money arising from said
sale to be applied in paying my debts, I bequeath to my
beloved wife all my house hold furniture & plates
8 years & a Month more & a Brown Horse & two Cows & the
largest of my Bulls, and the remainder of my Estate after
debts are paid to be equally divided among my four
dear sisters Viz Elizabeth, Margaret & Jane Stewart
and do hereby nominate & appoint my beloved wife Isobel
Stewart & my dear friend James Houston as my executors
to this my last will & Testament. Given under my hand
Death this 25th day of September 1777

In the Name of God Amen. I Henry Stevens a Gentleman of the County
of Rockbridge & State of Virginia being very weak of body
but of perfect memory & mind thanks be given to God calling
to mind the Mortality of my body, humbling that it is appointed
me for all men to die do make & ordain this my last will
& Testament. That is to say principally & first of all I give
& command my soul into the hands of Almighty God
that gave it. Secondly my body to be buried unto the土
in a decent & Christian manner at the discretion of
my Executors nothing doubting but the general Resur-
rection I shall receive the same again by the Right &
Power of God. And as touching such worldly Estate

wherewith it hath pleased the Almighty God to bless me
with, I give & devise & dispose of the same in the follow-
ing manner & form, First I order in my will that all my
temporal dues; debts & demands be paid out of my moveable
estate. Secondly I give & bequeath unto my well beloved
wife Elizabeth Sopman the following trust she is to
have full peaceable possession in the House wher in I
now live as long as she remains a widow & give her
her Bed & my bed while this she is to enjoy free besides
her third of the moveable goods, but if she marries
again said bed & her bed is to be sold & she to have the
third part of the sum & the remainder to be divided
amongst all my Children, & she is to receive twenty-
five pounds of hard money & she is to have of the money
which I have at present if enough & if not then the Re-
mainder as soon as it can be got this sum she is to have
per $\frac{1}{3}$ she marries or not. Thirdly I give & bequeath to my
well beloved son Henry Sopman being my bldest son the
sum of fifteen pounds hard money to be taken out of
my estate to be given to him Extraordinary of the rest &
then the improvement that I bought of Godfred Lipp
with three hundred acres of land to be left off to him
by partition, land to my son aniel Sopman the spring
which is up towards Stichleders with three hundred
acres adjoining Stichleders; And my son John Sopman
is to have my plantation with the mill after paying his
youngest brother Jacob Sopman the sum of one hundred
pounds of hard money for his part Equal or in proportion with
his brothers in the land way, also my son John is to have
4,000 bushels necessaries for the sustenance of his that is for
four hams & grain for hogs as many as may be sufficient
for his maintenance as long as he remains a widow.
And to my daughter Catherine Sopman the sum of twenty
five pounds of hard money to be taken out of the 15.00 &
and to my daughter Sophia Sopman the like sum of twenty
five pounds of hard money also out of said hand, & last
to my daughter Bethia Sopman the like sum of twenty

five pounds of her Money out of said Bonds, and to my daughter
Elizabeth Saffman the like sum of Twenty five pounds of her
Money out of said Bonds, and to my younger daughter Mary
Saffman the like sum of Twenty five pounds of her Money
of the same Bonds, and if there be any sum remaining out
of the Bonds or bonds that don't complete the said sum for
my daughters it shall be taken & divided out of my Marable
goods to complete said sums, & the Major & all the Re
mainder of my goods shall be sold at publice vender & my
just debts & charges shall be paid out of them & the
remainder shall be divided amongst all my Children after
my wife Elizabeth Saffman has Drawn her third of said
sum that is remaining of the Marables, This all I do give
& bequeath to the parties above mentioned by them freely
to be enjoyed - Also I do hereby Appoint & Ordain John
Bairinge & Daniel Bager my true & trusty friends as Ex
ecutors of this my last will & Testament, I do hereby did
attorn Preache all other wills, Testaments former legacies
executed long since before names, written & signed attorn, But
not affixing Confermation thereto no witness to be my last will &
Testament, In witness where I have hereunto set my hand
that this 28th day of January 1783 in the 7th year of the Re
ignion of George - Signed, Sealed, published & made
& declared by the said Henry Saffman as his last will &
Testament in the presence of us, both in his presence & in
