 that my wife, beloved wife, do survive my son Robert & my daughter
 Mary, & the Legates, & that my daughter should be the same, & also the
 child that she bears in payment thereof, to be given to the heirs of the money,
 & if she should die before her husband, to be given to her husband or his
 heirs, further it is my will if any of them, that should die with
 out an issue or in their issue, that their parts equally to be
 divided amongst the surviving children, & further it is my will
 that if my family should break up, that it should be divided equally
 together, & also my intention to make full of the whole of the property
 into bequeathed of, and further I do nominate & appoint my trusty
 friend David Freeman, Robert Gibson & my son Robert
 to execute to be my Executors of this my last will & Testament, and
 further I do the same, with the Legates hereafter, & charging
 & appointing them to be my last will & Testament, to be done in writing
 & that my beloved wife should be my sole executrix in the year 1788
 and in the fourth year of the same, and further I do
 appoint to be my Executors of this my last will & Testament,
