Thus witness on the 18<sup>th</sup> of lastly I constitute & appoint my Son in law Joseph Smith sole Executor of this my last will & Testament, Declaring this to be the only to be my last will & Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 18<sup>th</sup> day of September 1820.

23 In the name of God amen. I Hugh Kirkpatrick of the County of Chester being of full age & of sound mind being in a sick & low condition best of all and a dispensing mind have thought proper to make this my last will & testament as follows, after the payment of my just debts & funeral expenses — I bequeath to my wife Elizabeth Kirkpatrick a comfortable maintenance out of my estate during her life or widowhood & to hold the house & mansion house between now & then, but provided she should marry & continue to do as a child part out of my estate & no more. — I bequeath to my Sons John & James the plantation on Littleback creek adjoining the plantation in which James Boyce now lives, if this plantation should be to them more than an equal share of the estate they shall pay in proportion to the other Estates if less they shall draw in proportion. — I bequeath to my other Sons the remainder of my lands and an equal division of all my estate, also my daughter Alice desires to have an equal share with the rest by her becoming joint of her proportionate share, my desire is that my said son be

Agreeable Shares of my Estate in conformity with the Provisions  
Specified or excepted however is made in favour of my two  
Youngest Sons William & Thomas of one hundred dollars a Month  
Loving me from Mr. George Allen for the purpose of their better  
Schooling my sons William & Thomas. Further let it be Observed  
that in the division of my Property provision must be made  
for the Maintenance of my Sister in law Ellen Grier as I am  
under obligation to see her provided for -- Finally I appoint  
James Boyer & Thomas Kirkpatrick my Brother Executors of this my  
Last Will & Testament & impower them that if any of my Servants  
Should prove refractory & unprofitable on the Estate they may dismiss  
of them & make an equal division of the Money leaving the Legacies -

1st day of September 1776 -

In the name of God Amen. In the year of our Lord 1776. I Edward Linton  
of N<sup>o</sup>. Carolina in the County of Chester being Deathan and going my death &  
weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thankes be unto God therefore  
calling unto mind the Mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed  
for all men once to die. Do make & Order this my last Will & Testament.  
That is to say principally & first of all I give & command my soul  
into the hands of God that gave it & for my body I command it to the  
Earth to be buried in a Christian Cement like manner at the discre-  
tion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resur-  
rection I shall receive the same again by the Mighty power of God  
such as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God  
to bless me with in this life I give & deliver of the same in the fol-  
lowing form & manner. I will & ordain all debts & demands to be paid  
first of all that is due. I promise I give & bequeath <sup>Reserves</sup> to my Deafly brother  
John the fifth part of all; and to every of my Children I will & bequeath  
the fifth part of the Estate as there is joint with Mother & the Children, for  
it is my whole desire to have it so divided — And as for Samuel
