In the name of God amen. I Hugh McLean of Carolina
et C. A. de lauburg County (plantation) calling to mind my mortality
& that it is appointed for all men once to die considering
it to be my duty to settle my affairs touching worldly things
I would do it in the following manner, first that all my
last debts & personal charges besides, I give to my beloved
wife Anna my negro woman named Betsy clearing her natural
life or widowhood the said negro not to be taken away & if she
and lives her & his till she is to have her living on
Baptist, clearing the specified time my wife to have her living on
my plantation one bed & blanket such as she shall choose with
two cows such as she shall choose, two sheep all my household
furniture of every kind, Horses, carriages, sheep, Negro plantation
tools wagon & still to be sold the money to be divided between
my wife Anna and her daughter, Betsy who being had to
the value of the negro, and the plantation, & household eight & the
day of Augt 11 1805 by me J. McAlexander, plantation
owner live in the divided between my two sons James and
Joseph McLean the land to be the line between them up to the
mouth of the River which runs up said road to the line
James to have the part where he now lives, Joseph the part
where I now live I give it to them & their heirs

I do appoint my Son Hugh McCain of NC Carolina & William
Archibell of NC Carolina Executors of this my last Will & Testament &
I do disannul all former Wills, & Testaments before this time
named, And I do ratify & confirm this my other to be my last
Will & Testament. Given under my hand this 31st day of
December in the year 1805.

 laws of the State, provided the said Amy is well treated
 but if it can be made appear that she is not well treated I
 allow my Executrix to take her the said Amy & liberate her or
 put her in the hands of some person that will treat her well
Item I will & bequeath to my kind friend Sally Carson or such
 person as she may choose all my cattle, Sheep & Bed & Table wares
 household furniture & the like out of a note that I have upon
 William Huston. Item I will & bequeath to the said
 Sarah Carson my servant Item by her paying all my just
 debts & paying my funeral expenses & likewise my bed, Table
 clothes & Furniture forty Dollars & my Niece Sally Carson forty
 dollars, but it is not specified above I do hereby furthermore
 & impower my Executors to make sole judges of the Treatment
 that the said Amy may receive in the judgment of the said
 Elizabeth Henry. I do now nominate & appoint Bob
