In the name of God Amen, I Hugh McLean of St. Caroline
County (Planters) calling to mind my Mortality
& that it is appointed for all men once to die considering
it to be my duty to settle my Affairs Touching worldly things
I would do it in the following manner, first that all my
Just Debt & several charges be paid, I give to my beloved
wife Jane my negro woman named Pink clothing her natural
life or widowhood the said negro not to be taken away & if she
and lives her children she is to have the privilege to choose her
Master, during the aforesaid time my wife to have her living on
my plantation one bed & clothes such as she shall choose with
all the belonging to her, I give her my several Ware & household
two Cows such as she shall choose, two Sheep all my household
furniture of every kind, Horses, Cows, Sheep, Hogs plantations
tools Wagon & still to be sold, the Money to be divided between
my wife & her sons & her daughter, Difference being had to
the value of the negroes that fall to her & elsewhere by the
day of August 1805 by me & such that my plantations
now live on be divided between my two sons James and
Joseph & John the Creek to be the line between them up to the
mouth of the Cherokees Creek up to the mouth of the
James to have the part where he now lives, Joseph the part
where I now live I give it to them & their heirs

I do appoint my son Hugh McCain of N^c Carolina & William
 Asst. of S^c Carolina Executors of this my last Will & Testament &
 I do disavow all former Wills & Testaments, & for this time
 named, And I do ratify & confirm this & no other to be my last
 Will & Testament. Given under my hand this 31st day of
 December in the year 1805.

 body to be buried in a Christian manner; And as touching
 worldly affairs after all my just debts are paid, In the first
 place I will & bequeath to my beloved sister Nancy one dollar
 in money & all my wearing apparel, Then I will & bequeath to
 my beloved niece Elizabeth Henry the service of my servant
 Amy her life or during the life of said Elizabeth Henry, & at
 her death or the said Amy to be liberated according to the
 laws of the State, provided the said Amy is well treated
 but if it can be made appear that she is not well treated I
 allow my Executor to take her the said Amy & liberate her or
 put her in the hands of some person that will treat her well
Then I will & bequeath to my kind friends Sally Carson or Sarah
 Carson the same persons all my cattle, Sheep & Bird & also my
 household furniture & the balance of a note that I have upon
 William Weston. Then I will & bequeath to the said
 Sarah Carson my servant John by her paying all my just
 debts & expaying my funeral expenses & likewise my Son John
 Salmon to the sum of forty Dollars & my niece Sally & Hannah forty
 dollars, but it is not specified above I do hereby authorize
 & empower my Executors to in the sole judge of the Testament
 that the said Amy may receive in the possession of the said
 Elizabeth Henry. I do now nominate & appoint Job
