body & that it is appointed for all men once to die and being in perfect
mind & memory do constitute & make this my last will and
Testament. And first of all I do positively bequeath & order all my
just debts to be paid out of my personal estate by my executors
hereafter named. Then I do will all the land that I am now pos-
sessor of to my son Samuel Then I do will the negro boy named
Dick to my son Samuel, but I do allow him for his pay to
each year & to my grand daughter Eriana the sum of five pounds
to be paid by him to each of them at the time that I may be thought
most convenient for him by my Executors & Guardians hereafter
named. Then I do will the negro girl named Pat to my daughter
Mary. Then I do allow my son Samuel & my three daughters Mary
Eliana & Sarah each of them to be ~~be~~ portioned at the discretion of
my Executors & Guardians as near equal to my love Eliabeth &
Abigail that are provided for by the estate will allow of Then I do be-
queath to my grand daughter Eriana Then I do allow the
negro boy till he comes of age to my son Samuel. Then I do devise
I bequeath my estate to be paid to all except such things as are bequeathed
to his family & one of his servants. Then I do allow the sum of one of my
estate to be disposed of at the discretion of my Executors & Guardians
as the necessities of any of the legates may require. Then I do hereby
constitute & appoint my son Samuel & my son John William Thomas
Executors & Trustees in law Samuel William & Thomas Guardians

of this my last will & testament, And I do hereby revoke & annul all other wills & testaments I do heretofore, & this be my last will & testament Given under my hand & seal this 2^d day of February, 1792.

32 In the name of God Amen, I James McEwen of the County of Northumberland & State of Carolina, being in a sick & low condition of body but in a perfect & regular Exercise of mind & Reason I do hereby, Do make and Ordain this my last will & testament & desire it may be received by all concerned as such. First I will & bequeath to my dear & loving wife Esther after my just debts are regularly discharged one third part of all my personal Estate to & for her use & the Remaining two thirds of my personal Estate to remain in the hands of my Executors or a majority of them ~~may think right~~ hereafter named during her life to supply her in her necessity as my Executors or a majority of them may think right & best she being at all times under the direction & subject to the Council & guardianship of my Executors as long as she remains my Widow at her decease the said two thirds or what Balance may be on hand I will & bequeath to my niece Mary Boyde & should my Executors find my personal Estate insufficient to support my Widow then They are to have recourse to my real Estate as far as they may deem necessary. As to my Real Estate I will & bequeath that tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County of Lincoln on Long creek containing one hundred & fifty four acres to my nephew Thomas Boyde to his only use & behoof forever after the decease of my Widow - As to the Tract of Land lying in the Waxhaws which I purchased from John Gillsapie I will & bequeath it to my Executors power to dispose of it by sale to the best advantage or opportunity they may have the amount or price of said Tract of Land lying on Long creek South Carolina, I will & bequeath to the above named Mary Boyde & should she die before the decease of my Widow then & in that case to be divided among said Mary Boyde her three & best or equally then & there. Lastly I do hereby constitute my truly & loving friends Thomas Boyde James Parks & Hugh McEwen to be the Executors of this my last will & testament.
