 3rd I Will to Polly Hanson my daughter a negro boy
 named Andrew a good horse one bed & clothes one pair of
 boots & wheel - 4th I Will to Stephen Hanson my son Ten
 dollars - 5th I Will to Abby Baerwright my daughter
 Ten dollars, 6th I Will to William Hanson my son
 Ten dollars, 7th I Will to Samuel C. Hanson my son
 all the balance of my Estate, I constitute & appoint
Samuel C. Hanson my Executor to settle my Estate -
 In testings whereof I have set my hand & seal this 9th
 day of April in the year of our Lord 1891 -
 signed in the presence of us.

 I do hereby constitute & appoint my dear brother Daniel
Chesnut & my friend Washington Morrison the Executors of
 this my last Will & Testaments in Witness whereof I have

I Will unto my well beloved wife Ann full possession
 of all my property during her life, I Will unto William
Bibb my negro woman child, Greaser & Philip & at the
 death of wife my man Hall, And at his death William
Bibb & at his death to his heirs the above named negroes -
 I Will & bequeath to William Bibb the son of William
Bibb has none in possession the offspring of my woman Greaser
 & at the death of my wife my negro boy Edley & at the
 death of him viz William Bibb to his heirs forever.
 I Will unto Philip & Bibb my negro man Henry &
Larry & my girl Edley to have his lifetime and at his
 death to his heirs forever -
