joining the land of the Heirs of David Hest - Then I bequeath

including this my mansion house & if my son William does
not settle the half the half of my land bequeathed to him in three
years from the date hereof & live on the same, in the time
of three years It is my will that my daughter Mary McConkie
shall have the full & portion of the same half of my land
with the said William Porter to live on & live It is for ever - & I
do will to my daughter Mary's daughter Mary Ann Porter my
& her heirs & by all laws to be made to her or descended to her
so that she may get the same at eighteen years of age out of
my estate, and lastly I do hereby Ordain & appoint my son
Joseph McConkie & Robert Stearn Executors of this my last will
testifying & pronouncing this & none other my last will signed
by me in the presence of us who sign in the name of Hugh Porter
this 6th day of June 1843

negro girl Cynthia. Also pay into the hands of my grand daughter Esther Kerr
or into the hands of her legal representative when called upon to do the sum of Twenty
dollars, in full consideration of his receiving the above named
negro girl Cynthia.

in one year after my decease or at any time thereafter when legally called upon
 so to do the sum of Twenty dollars 20th I give devise & bequeath to my son in law
George Henry of Mecklenburg County N. Carolina my Negro woman called
Phoebe & the child she is now pregnant with should it be born & live, to have
 to hold the same, Provided nevertheless my will is that he pay into the
 hands of Esther Isabella Isabella Priest daughter of James Priest now
 of Tennessee or into the hands of her legal representatives in one year
 after my decease or at any time thereafter when legally called upon
 the sum of forty dollars; and also in one year after my decease
 or at any time thereafter when called upon so to do pay into the
 hands of my Executor Isaac Priest the further sum of twenty dollars
 the more fully to enable him to discharge my debts and further
 more I give devise & bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Henry wife of
 the said George Henry my set of clothes as it stands in my cupboard to
 gother with one half of all the other furniture of the said cupboard
 5th I give devise & bequeath to my grand daughter Esther Priest daughter
 of Isaac Priest one feather bed & furniture in like manner I give unto
 my grand daughter Esther Henry daughter of George Henry one feather
 bed & furniture & further I give & bequeath to Esther Priest daughter

Anne Henry daughter of George Henry one feather bed & furniture & further I give & bequeath to Esther Price daughter of Isaac Price my Chest & Table, and as touching my bearing apparel my will is that it be equally divided between my two daughters Mary Ann & Marian Henry, and further as to any other articles of my property which have not been mentioned & disposed of, my will is that they go into the hands of my Executor to be disposed of as he may think proper, As to my old negro woman named Poll my will & devise is that she remain with & be taken care of by my son Isaac Price and I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint the above named Isaac Price my son to be the sole Executor of this my last will & Testament, hereby revoking & making void all & every other will & wills at any time heretofore by me made, & do declare this to be my last will & Testament. In witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 2nd day of May in the Year of our Lord 1815.
