do will to my daughter Mary O'Farrell the Robert Stearn my son  
of whom her \$1000 by the time to be paid to her or secured to her

of China excepted & the cupboard to have & to hold the same, & my  
will is that out of this property he pay all my just debts & the  
remaining of them be any that be appropriate it to his own use  
etc. I give & bequeath to my son in law Henry Kerr  
of the State of Kentucky his heirs executors administrators or assigns  
my negro boy called Bachelor to have & to hold the same, & nothing  
more & less & my will is that the said Henry Kerr pay into the  
hands of his daughter Esther Kerr or into the hands of her legal  
representation when called upon to do the sum of Twenty  
dollars, in consideration of his receiving the above named  
boy for his. Also to my beloved daughter Mary Kerr wife  
of the said Henry Kerr I give & bequeath the further sum  
whereon I commonly live together with the odd lands & all the  
immoveable & to beloning - 3d I give & bequeath to my  
beloved son W. Price who is now in the State of Tennessee  
his Heirs executors administrators or assigns my negro  
girl named Cynthia to have & to hold the same. Provided  
now that less & my will is that the aforesaid William Price - in  
consideration of his receiving the above named negro girl  
as aforesaid in the hands of my grand daughter Esther

manus, & understanding promised to God for the same do make & declare this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following & sigd. & I give & bequeath unto my beloved son James Picard as he is now long administrators or executors my negro boy in name Matt to him to hold the same free from any encumbrance whatsoever, also to my said son James Picard give the same thing as the my negro woman named Dinah & her child which she now has to, other with the one half of a common road way upon which he & I hold in copartnership & my half of the farming utensils which are held in the same man. also my horses creatures, horned cattle Sheep & Hogs also all my Kitchen furniture & Ferry boat community called a flat together with one half of my cupboard, & a number (not of China excepted) of the cupboard, to have & to hold the same, & my will is that out of this property he pay all my just debts & the remainder if there be any shall be appropriate it to his own use &c. I give diverse & bequeath to my son in law Henry Kerr of the State of N. either his Heirs Executors Administrators or Agents my negro boy called Beckers to have & to hold the same provided nevertheless & my will is that the said Henry Kerr pay into the hands of his daughter Lettice Kerr or into the hands of her legal representation whom called upon to do the sum of Twenty dollars, in consideration of his receiving the above named boy in his hands. Also to my beloved daughter Mary Kerr wife of the said Henry Kerr I give & bequeath the portion house whereon I commonly lie together with the orchard & all in the same thereon belonging - 3d I give & bequeath to my labor's son W. Picard now in The State of N. either his Heirs Executors Administrators or executors my negro girl named Cynthia to have & to hold the same. Provided nevertheless & my will is that the above named William Picard in consideration of his receiving the above named negro girl Cynthia do pay into the hands of my grand daughter Lettice Kerr daughter of Henry Kerr or into the hands of her legal representation.

in one year after my decease or at any time thereafter when called upon  
 to do so the sum of Twenty dollars to give division & begin with to my daughter  
George Henry of Rockingham County N Carolina my Negro woman called  
 Phoebe & the child she is now pregnant with should it be born & live to have  
 to hold the same, Provided nevertheless my will is that he pay into the  
 hands of Lettie Babette Adelicia Price daughter of James Price now  
 of Tennessee or into the hands of her legal representatives in one year  
 after my decease or at any time thereafter when legally called upon  
 - the sum of forty dollars; but also in one year after my decease  
 or at any time thereafter when called upon so to do pay into the  
 hands of my Executor James Price the further sum of forty dollars  
 the same fully to enable him to discharge my debts and further  
 more I give also in & begin with to my daughter George Henry wife of  
 the said George Henry my set of bibles as it stands in my cupboard to  
 go ther with over half of all the other furniture of the said cupboard  
 5<sup>th</sup> I give division & begin with to my grand daughter Lettie Price daughter  
 of James Price one feather bed & furniture like manner I give unto  
 my grand daughter Eliza Henry daughter of George Henry one feather  
 bed & furniture & further I give & begin with to Lettice Price a quantity  
 of rice & Price my Chest & Table, and as touching my wearing apparel  
 my will is that it be equally divided between my two daughters  
Eliza Kerr & George Henry, and further as to every other article of my  
 property which have not been mentioned & disposed of, my will is that  
 they go into the hands of my Executor to be disposed of as he may  
 think fit, also as to my old Negro woman named Pott my will is  
 division as that she remain with & be taken care of by my son James Price  
 and I do hereby nominate constable & appoint the above named  
James Price my son to be the sole Executor of this my last will  
 & Testament, hereby revoking & making void all former other wills  
 & testaments at any time heretofore by me made, & do declare this to be  
 my last will & Testament. In witness hereof I have hereunto set my  
 hand & seal this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of May in the year of our Lord 1815.  
 I do declare and declare & publish by the above named  
 Lettice Price the Testator as for her last will & Testament  
 in the presence of us who at her request & in her presence  
 did the business & such other business lawfully transacted thereon

to hold the same, Provided nevertheless my will is that he pay into the hands of Ethie Babette Colleide Price daughter of Jasen Price now of Tennessee or into the hands of her legal representatives in one year after my decease or at any time thereafter when legally called up on the sum of forty dollars; and also in one year after my decease or at any time thereafter when called upon so to do pay into the hands of my Executor here Price the further sum of fifty dollars the more fully to enable him to discharge my debts and further more I give devise & bequeath to my daughter Mattha Henry wife of the said George Henry my set of bibles as it stands in my cupboard together with one half of all the other furniture of the said cupboard 5<sup>th</sup> I give devise & bequeath to my grand daughter Lethia Price daughter of Jasen Price one feather bed & furniture like manner I give unto my grand daughter Ex. Lethia Henry daughter of George Henry one feather bed & furniture & further I give & bequeath to Lethia Price daughter of Jasen Price my Chest & Table. And as touching my wearing apparel my will is that it be equally divided between my two daughters Mattha Henry & Martha Henry and further as to any other articles of my property which have not been mentioned & disposed of my will is that they go into the hands of my Executor to be disposed of as he may think proper. As to my old negro woman named Patti my will & desire is that she remain with & be taken care of by my son Jasen Price and I do hereby nominate constable & appoint the above named

named Jasen Price my son to be the sole Executor of this my last will & Testament, hereby revoking & making void all & every other will & wills at any time heretofore by me made, & do declare this to be my last will & Testament. In witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of May in the year of our Lord 1815.
