 is to say principally & first of all I recommend my soul
 to Almighty God who gave it, & my body to the Earth
 from whence it was taken to be buried at the desire
 tion of my executors, And as touching such worldly
 estate as here with it hath pleased God to bless me in this
 life I give & bequeath in the manner following --
 Item all my just debts & several charges to be paid
 as soon as can conveniently be done. Item To my wife
Mary Reid I give one two year old Heifer &
 to her son John Reid one yearling heifer, - To my
 son Jamie Reid I give one two year old heifer & one
 yearling colt, To my son John Reid I give a
 brown two year old Heifer & one yearling colt
 To my son Thomas Reid two Heifers & ten pounds
 of tobacco in currency To Mary Reid my daughter
 I give one two year old heifer & one yearling colt
 & to Hannah McTell my daughter I give
 inqueath forty pounds North Carolina currency. To my
 grand daughter Agneta McTell I give a side saddle
 & harness leather & iron bound in North Carolina currency
 To Hannah McTell I give one cow & Lodowick McTell
 my grand daughter I give one cow, - To John McTell
 my grandson I give forty pounds North Carolina cur-
 rency, - To my son William Reid I give & bequeath
 all my lands with houses & all improvements pertaining
 exclusive of one hundred & fifty acres of land on the
 northwest side of my plantation which I give to my
 said son John Reid wherein he has made some im-
 provements of late days after the

it is appointed for all men to die. Do make this my last
will & testament in the manner following. That
is to say principally first of all I recommend my soul

of tobacco currency. To Mary Beck my daughter
I give one two year old hipe & one Yearling colt
& to Hannah & William I give my daughter & give her
in queath Forty pounds of tobacco currency. To my
grand daughter Agnes McTell I give a side saddle
& harness leather & Ten pounds in tobacco currency
To Hannah & Tom I give one cow & Tobacco Mif
my grand daughter I give one cow. - To John McPate
my grandson I give forty pounds North Carolina cur-
rency. - To my son William Reed I give & bequeath
all my lands with houses & all thereunto pertaining
Exclusion of one hundred & fifty acres of land on the
northwest side of my plantation which I give to my
son John Reed wherein he has made some im-
provements. The remainder of all my estate after the
above mentioned bequests are settled & paid. I do
give to my son William Reed wherein I give him

by present my sole Executress of this my last Will &
Testament, and I do hereby utterly revoke & disannul
all my former Wills, Testaments & bequests by me so
merely made & satisfying, allowing & desirous this to be
my last Will & Testament, to the date above mentioned
Provenante, the ~~10th~~ day of October 1750 sealed by him.

In the name of God. amen. I begonesse Reed of the County
of Northumberland in the State of North Carolina being very sick &
weak in body but of full & sound mind & memory thanks be given
unto God calling unto mind the Mortality of my body & know-
ing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and
ordain this my last will & Testament, that is to say Principally
& first of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of
almighty God that gave it, & my body I recommend to the
earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the execu-
tion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the
general resurrection I shall receive the same again by
the mighty power of God. And as touching such worldly
estate wherewithal I have pleased God to bless me in this life
I give devise & dispose of the same in the following manner
as follows First I give & bequeath to Elizabeth my dearest
Intestate before the signing hereof five pounds lawful money
of North Carolina in gold or silver coin to be paid & with
out of my estate together with the gray mare & colt be-
longing to the same & a side saddle my best black leather the
weight of my metal body that is to say one hundred & six
pounds & like wise three plates of delf a half a dozen
of flasks of delf two Milch Cows viz Mary & wife each
