 God to God my mother beseeching his most gracious reception  
 of it through the merits of Jesus Christ, I give my body to the earth  
 from whence it was taken in full assurance of its resurrection  
 from thence at the last day, as for my burial I desire it may  
 be decent at the discretion of my dear wife & my executors  
 hereafter named; as to my worldly estate I will & positively order  
 that all my first debts be paid & given & bequeath to my beloved  
 wife one black mare together with her saddle & bridle & to have  
 three milch cows for herself out of my cattle & one sheep & one  
 sheep that she may have & likewise three geese & two  
 turkeys & the whole of the gear, likewise one bed & furniture  
 together with the whole of the household furniture of either kind  
 & to have the use of the lands on which I now live to raise the  
 children & to be supported off said land herself during her natural  
 life or widowhood & that my lands be equally divided between  
 my two sons Elam & Henry Long. I give & bequeath to my daughter  
 Priscilla one bed & furniture & the sum and value of my property  
 to be sold at Vendue as soon as may be convenient after my death  
 & to be equally divided between my three children that are now  
 & the one that my wife is now pregnant with & if that is a boy  
 that then the other two boys pay to him out of the value of the  
 lands what may make them equal shares, & as for my farm  
 I leave them for the use of the plantations, & I likewise  
 order that the plantation be not removed off the hands of my wife  
 & children so as it may be exposed to damage.

And I do constitute & appoint my son Henry Hunter & my wife  
 Margaret Hunter executors of this my last will & testament, confirming  
 & acknowledging this & no other as my last will & testament  
 in witness whereof I have unto set my hand & seal this 25 day of  
 July in the year of our Lord 1804 -

my two sons Elam & Henry Lang. I give & bequeath to my daughter  
the Peiray one bed & furniture & the remainder of my property  
to be sold at Vandue as soon as may be convenient after my death  
& to be equally divided between my three children that are now  
of the one that my wife is now pregnant with & if that is a boy  
that then the other two boys pay to him out of the value of the  
lands what may make them equal shares, and as for my farmey  
Hendrie I leave them for the use of the plantations, & I likewise  
desire that the plantation be not removed off the hands of my wife  
& children so as it may be exposed to damage.

And I do constitute & appoint my sonne Henry Hunter & my wife  
Margaret Hunter Executors of this my last will & testament, confirming  
& acknowledging this & no other as my last will & testament  
in witness whereof I have set my hand & seal this 25 day of
