Know all men by these presents that I Isaac Price of the state of North Carolina in Robeson County being in a low state of health at of present and disposing mind and memory do constitute and ordain this to be my last will and testament in manner and form as follows.

Article 1st, I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Nancy Price, my two negroes Betty and Milton also my negro girl to have and to hold forever also three Beads if a separation of her property and my children should take place also the land I live on to my widow during her life or widowhood if she should marry my will is that she shall be compelled to the Dower of my mother.

Article 2nd, I will to my son Isaac Jasper Price after the incumbrance of his mother is done the plantation I now live on I do value this land at 100 dollars and a half per acre — also I will and bequeath to my two Sons Thomas Barnell Price & John James Price my Hately land in Fayette County Fayette containing four hundred and twenty six acres to be divided equally between them agreeable to quantity and quality I do value that land at four dollars per acre.

Article 4th my will is that my share of the
C.R. River land in Carter County Tennessee
be sold and the title ~~transferred~~ by my
executors and paid into such the money
arising from the sale of said land
to be taken by my guardian as of
shall hereafter appoint and put out at
Interest for the sole use of my son Thomas
Price to purchase a tract of land
with when he becomes of age.

Article 5th, I constitute and appoint
my beloved wife "Mary Price" and my
brother Jacob Johnson MacLean my
sole guardian.

Article 6th all the balance of my estate
personal or real I leave in trust to my
guardian for the benefit of my children
Thomas B. Price Johnson Price, ~~James~~ Price
Sarah S. Price, Ann J. Price & Mary
M. Price and Jane M. B. Price; my
my desire is that all this property shall
be kept together with of my wifes and
co-heirs to gather for the benefit of my
family in general unless my children
after they become of age I should wish
to sell them in that case I wish
my guardian to give them off such
property as they think the family
can conveniently share
my will is that the property given
off to my children by my
guardian shall be valued at
the time given off

by two dutch tions neighbours and the
 valuation of said property to be kept
 by a Surveyor do that where a final
 settlement shall be place after my
 dying so soon becomes of age each
 child shall share and have alike
 should my wife marry. But
 Marry my will is that all of the
 children property should be given
 up to the care of John D. MacLean
 my guardian I wish him or the
 children to build house on the Hill for
 the children all to live in and to
 attend to their farm and it is my
 will that they have the use of my
 bottom Gin Island and smelt shop
 whenever they want it I do constitute
 and appoint two friends Adam
 King and Dr. John D. MacLean
 my sole Executors to settle my Estate,
 in witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand and affixed
 my seal this 10th day of June 1833
