half of my Kitchen, furniture, two plates one Glass
and the necessary bears, for the two above —

It is my will & desire that my executor lay off out of the
provisions on hand what will be sufficient to support
my dear wife, my five children & family till the new
crop is gathered and provided there should not be any
on hand, that it be furnished at the expense of my estate
and when the present crop is gathered I desire my said
executor to lay off therefrom one year provisions suf-
ficient for the support of my wife five children and
family, provided she keep the children without expen-
se. It is my will & pleasure that my heirs after named

should sell at their discretion so much of my said
estate before disposed of as shall be by them tho-
roughly sufficient to purchase a small tract of land for the
use & benefit of my wife & my five children and their
heirs forever interest and profits of said land be for the

It is my will that the portions allowed for said Decedent be equally divided between the surviving Brothers & Sisters.

6th. It is my will & desire that the two negroes Sandy & Eliza claimed to my wife during natural life in the 2^d Place of will be hers forever -

7th. I do hereby appoint & constitute my worthy friend & James Wilson Executor of this my last will herein - Revoking all others and have hereunto subscribed my own name in presence of
