I Jane Cathy of the County of York in the
State of N. Carolina being in a low State of health
but of perfectly sound in my mind and memory
And calling to mind the mortality of the body and
knowing that it is appointed for all men to die
I do make & constitute this to be my last will & testament
And first of all I commend my soul to God who gave it and
my body to its mother Earth to be decently buried by my
Exeutors And as for what worldly property it has pleased
the Lord to bless me it is my will & pleasure that it be
disposed of in the following manner (Viz) It is my will
and pleasure that my only son William Cathy & his
children have my yellow dye land and Dunes & his three
children that is David Charles & Morris and all the
spring which she may hereafter have and also my
Plantation formerly known by the name of the old
Place also all my stock of cattle & my two beds
& furniture And all my household & kitchen furniture
to be at his own dispose after paying any little debts
that may be now or that may arise about my
funeral expenses I hereby make all other wills & testaments by me
made and establish this and no other to be my last will & testament
Signed & executed this 5th day of November 1816
