tho' of perfect mind & memory, yet calling to mind the mortality of my
body, & that it is appointed for all men to die, do make & declare
this to be my last Will & Testament, And in the first place I resign my
body to the grave and my soul to God who gave it, my body to be
buried decently according to the Discretion of my Executors -
And in the next place, I will & bequeath that all my lawfull debts
be punctually paid, together with the my former expenses -
I will I bequeath unto my son William Leary one bed & furniture
together with the my furniture - I will I bequeath that all the other
property of which I am possessed (except my lands) to be sold & the
money paid to be lent for my son William, the land to be kept for
my son William, any business debts due to me to be managed for
the benefit of my son; I allow him to get whatever Education
is necessary, And if my son should die without heirs, my estate
is to be divided equally among my Brothers, John & Lees, James
& John Lees. I do also bequeath & appoint my respectable &
Trusty & affectionate son William Leary to be the Executor of my last Will
& Testament, & I do hereby disclaim & utterly deny all other Wills & Testaments
And do declare this to be my last Will & Testament. Given under my
