sound mind & memory blessed in God, do from a sense of the
injustice of the 25th day of October 1749 make & declare this my
will & testament nullifying all other former wills & testaments
& bequests by me heretofore made - - infirmis. I recommend the
soul of my body into the hands of almighty God who gave it
& my body to the earth from whence it came - Item I give and
bequeath unto my Daughter Polly my two negro children of birth
named Abram & Sarah on the following conditions Viz I should my
decease, when I am to live more than ten miles from where my son
Robert may live with the negro boy Samuel shall belong to my
son Robert & Mrs. Hines on his paying my son George one half
of his share of the negro girl Sarah & I give & bequeath to my grand
son James McComb to belong to him together with the increase
upon the death of my said daughter Polly my bed & furniture
& one half of my part of the kitchen & stable, 100 shillings and my
right of the 1/2 of my daughter or her Polly Phillips death
part of my said bequest as she my said daughter may choose, to
be the Hines, never within the above district - - & instructions
I give & bequeath my young man called Edley to my daughter Anna
Phillips provided my son William pays my son
George one dollar - I give & bequeath to my son James
my one 1/2 of the increase to them & their heirs, or one
I give my other half of the kitchen & stable, 100 shillings to my
son Robert - what one shall, as the 1/2 of my share
of my daughter I desire to be paid to & in amount hereof I

Give & devise to my son George - I nominate constitute
& appoint my sons John & Robert Phillips or either of
them is act as my Executors To this my last will and
Testament Given under my hand & seal the above date
Signed Sealed & acknowledged in presence of us

In the Name of God Amen, I William Potts of Middlesex
County & State of Virginia, being sick & weak in body
through proper which my Judgment remains sound and my
memory respect think proper to dispose of what is worth by
Estate it has pleased a kind Providence to bless me in this life
in measure & some following to wit Impressis it is my
will that all my Just debts be paid out of my Estate
There I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Lydia Potts
the one third of all my negroes as her, as she continues to be
my widow & in case of her remarriage with any other
person it is my will & desire that thereafter all the said
negroes be the sole property of my son James except a
girl by the name of Mary which shall be hers during
natural life then she & her offspring if any to be the
property of my two children Mary & James to share &
share alike her share. I give & bequeath to my wife Lydia
the one third of all my household & kitchen furniture
one third of all my stock of horses & cattle, sheep, Hogs &c. to her
& her heirs forever & likewise the value & conveyance of the house
in which I now live & her maintenance for me off this said
estate of Land during her widowhood or life

There I give & bequeath unto my daughter Mary the one third
of all my personal property to wit of negroes Household and
kitchen furniture Horses, Cattle, sheep, Hogs &c. to her & her
heirs forever - There I give & bequeath unto my son James
all my Land to wit the plantation on which I now live
the mill tract on the 6 mile creek & all other pieces of
