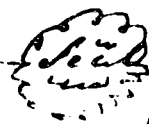
- 22 In the name of God Amen. I James Campbell former living in

Years & being for some time sitting in Bed & calling to mind my
mortality knowing that it is appointed for all men once, I choose
to make this my last Will & Testament, and first I recommend my
Soul to Almighty God who gave it, begging in words accept the same
for Christ's sake, and as it hath pleased God to bless me with a
family and a small portion of this world's goods, I choose to
dispose of the same in the following manner, and first I
allow all my Just & Lawfull debts to be discharged
I bequeath unto my well beloved wife Jane Campbell the one
third of all my Estate Real or personal during life or widowhood
together with her spinning wheel weaving & Spindle & bed & bed
and furniture
Item I bequeath unto Elizabeth my daughter five Shillings
Sterling besides what she hath already received
Item I bequeath unto my Daughter Grace Burton five Shillings
Sterling besides what she hath already got
Item I bequeath unto my Son James Campbell five Shillings
Sterling besides what he hath already received

Then I bequeath unto my son Andrew Campbell all the rest of my Estate Real & Personal, Lands Goods or Chattels moveables of all kinds to him and his Heirs —

Then I appoint & nominate my wife Jane Campbell & Andrew Campbell my son to be my only Executors of this my last will & Testament and by their presents do revoke all other wills & Testaments what soever I have made giving this as my last Will this 18th day of June in the year 1783 — And as such affixing my hand & seal to the same the day & year above written in presence of

In the name of God Amen. I Thomas Cochran of Mecklenburg County & State of N^o Carolina, being at present weak in body but of a sound & disposing memory & understanding & calling to mind the uncertainty of this life & that it is appointed unto all men once to die, do make & bequeath this my last will & Testament in manner & form following, Principally & first of all, I recommend my soul to God who gave it & my body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like & decent manner at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named And as touching such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give & dispose of the same in the manner & form following; First I Will that my just debts & several charges be paid and satisfied as soon as convenient after my decease —

Then I Give & bequeath unto my well beloved wife Sarah one certain bed & furniture, and at her choice of any one of my sons & her Galt be sides what is allowed her as dower by Law, together with the whole benefit of the whole of the plantation whereon I now live for the schooling &c of my children my youngest son, comes to the age of 21 years if so that she remains my widow but if during that time she marries she is thence forth to have her part of the Land as is allowed by Law, And my Children (such as is not then come of age) to be bound by the will of my Executors shall succeed
