then or owing or hereafter to be due or owing to me to be equally
divided between them if both be alive then & dead alike.
But in case either should be dead or die before the present
I shall be succeeded & said sum agreeable to this Bequest, then
it is my will & pleasure that the whole amount shall be
paid to the survivor for her separate use & benefit to be used
for me - and to the end that my Sister or Sisters may realize
the benefit of this Bequest as soon as practicable after my
Death it is my will & pleasure that my Executors & Cest
