& parcel of Land wherein Frederick Taylor now lives & also
I will & bequeath a tract & parcel of Land to my son John
now lying in the hand of Col. Thomas King now living in
the State of Tennessee Hawkins County, and all the rest of
my property such as Horses Cattle household furniture
plantation tools, Carpenter Tools, &c. I will I bequeath to be
and to be equally divided among my Children except one
womans saddle to be taken out, for my Daughter Mary Ann
