life thirteen negroes viz Warren, Rachel, George, Lucy, Jim, Robin
Eliza & me, six children viz William, Mary, Harriet & Abram, Hiram &
John, the rest Smith, my best wagon, two horses & mire mule & choice
lot taken out of my farm, twenty head of cattle (large & small) Twenty
head of sheep & Thirty head of Stock hogs, & as much of the stock crop & provision
valued as will be fully sufficient for the decent support of herself & family
for one year, also one fourth part of my library of Books such as she may
choose, together with so much of the household & kitchen, laundry, farm
ing tools, Smith tools, &c she may think proper to keep for the use of herself
& family, also the care of the plantation which as I now see, will go into
form of her natural life, also one good strong pig & a mule except such
part of said plantation as shall not lie in deeper ground.

I give & bequeath to my son John Denkins all the land
I have owned from Adam, Alexander, John, Alexander & Lucy & Austin, wherein
the said lands now lies intermixing about, four hundred & Twenty acres
together with all the negroes & other property he has received from me and
now in the possession of, together with my negro servant Willis Gaspard
increased to him in these Houses, &c.

I give & bequeath to my daughter Penisca Denkins all the negroes and
other property she has received from me & now in the possession of, together
with my negro boy named to her & her heirs forever.

I give & bequeath to my daughter Sarah Branch all the negroes & all
other property she has received from me & now in the possession of, together
with my negro girl named to her & her heirs forever.

I give & bequeath to my son Rufus R Denkins all that tract of land
I purchased from William Burton lying on both sides of that creek
containing about five hundred & twenty acres, together with five negroes
viz Hercules, Hind, Lucy, Joe & Sarah, my gray horse Billy my youngest
hund, one good saddle & bridle, my plain old watch, one fourth part
all my books, one bed & furniture, two cows & calves, two sheep & pigs, a
set of farming tools, such as can be made in my shop, sufficient for the

and my wife and with my children
I am now a negro Virg. Warren, Rachel George, baby. I have
three children 183 Miles from H. & C. & A. Hambleton
and of my wife, Smith, my best wagon, two horses & mire mule mchd
of sheep & thirty head of black hogs, 4 as much of the stock crop & growing
one horse also one fourth part of my library of Books such as she may
choose together with so much of the necessaries which will be necessary
to all, Mr. Smith to take care of the negroes & his dependents except such
as are natural life & in case of death, & the rest of land
from the plantation or slave now for me to keep for the use of herself
& his children & his wife, Elizabeth Denkins, & her husband & twenty acres
the said lands more time intervening about four hundred & twenty acres
together with all the negroes & other property he has received from me and
now in the possession of together with all the negroes and
increased to him & his heirs forever -

I give & bequeath to my daughter Sarah Denton to all the negroes & all the

in Pennsylvania & New Jersey lying on both sides of that creek
under one hundred & twenty rods & there being no other with five rods
all my boats, one bed & furniture, my plain clothes & beddy my young goat
lambda & horses to work with together with five rods
beds to be raised on it is my estate not otherwise appropriated taking
the same to my daughter Sarah during her natural life eight nego-
